Race 1

Race 7

#1 FLYINGBYU (E) (Speed) May have lost chances when acting up in the gate prior to his latest over the track and distance at this distance last month in his first start since March and second of the year. Trainer Bigelow ins with 20% of his claimers and son of Margie's Wildcat has won three of five starts here. Dark bay won twice at this level or better last meet and may be the one to catch with Murrill retaining the mount.

#3 LA FORCE (D) (Closer) Ships from California where she was last seen when second in a Grade Two at Santa Anita in late-April in her first start of the year and will try an all-weather track for the first time. Five-year-old finished second in three Grade One events last year for trainer Gallagher who wins with 28% of his runners second off a layoff. Dark bay is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and Current Class and can be along from off the pace with Valdivia taking the mount.

Arlington International Expert Selections and Value Plays
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RACE 1

#1 FLYINGBYU (E) (Speed) May have lost chances when acting up in the gate prior to his latest over the track and distance at this distance last month in his first start since March and second of the year. Trainer Bigelow ins with 20% of his claimers and son of Margie's Wildcat has won three of five starts here. Dark bay won twice at this level or better last meet and may be the one to catch with Murrill retaining the mount.

#2 BAJAN RHYTHM (D) (Closer) Has not been seen since giving way badly after making some early progress at this distance at Hawthorne in early December. Son of Speightstown has won two of four starts on this oval and posted a sharp four-furlong work in 46 seconds last month for trainer Miller who wins with 11% of her runners that have not raced for 90 days or more. Chestnut can be along from off the pace with Kennedy in the saddle.

#5 LITTLE BALTAR (E) (Stalker) Is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and comes off a second-place finish after chasing the early leaders over the track and distance at this level last month. Trainer Spanabel failed to win with last ninety runners in claiming events but gelding is also first on Current Class and can be in good early position with Skyler Spanabel riding.

#3 VBREEZE (E) (Presser) Was not a threat when unplaced over the track and distance at this level in his latest last month but has a record of 11-1-2-1 on this track. Trainer Haran wins with just 4% of runners on all-weather surfaces but with 10% of his claimers and dark bay can be forwardly placed from the start and a contender for a share with Santiago in the irons.

#6 GREENHORN (E) (Presser) Comes off a fifth-place finish in an even effort over the track and distance at this level last month. Five-year-old has hit the board in six of fifteen starts here and trainer Poulos wins with 12% of runners in claiming events. Bay can be near the front early with Doyle aboard.

#4 LITTLE IKE (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish fifth after leading early at this level over a mile and a sixteenth in his latest last month. Trainer Rodriguez won with four of his first ten runners this meet but gelding has failed to hit the board in all three tries on this track.

#7 DASHING DEREK (D) (Presser) Second runner from the Spanabel barn gave way badly when unplaced over six furlongs facing better here early last month. Gelding has won one of nine starts here and has some early speed but still seems unlikely to find enough improvement on his latest to be a contender.

RACE 2

#1 POINT STREAK (U) (Speed) Showed her liking for the surface when drawing off to win her first start on this oval by over nine lengths after leading from the start last month. Daughter of Majestic Warrior has now won two of twelve career starts and trainer Hartman wins with 27% of his claimers that won last time out. Gray figures to be sent again breaking from the rail with Kennedy remaining aboard.

#4 VIOLA MARIE (D) (Presser) Weakened to finish fifth after setting pressured early fractions facing better in her latest over the track and distance last month and has won one of three starts here. Trainer Pompell wins with 9% of his claimers and four-year-old can be near the front from the start under Santiago who won with three of last twelve rides for the barn.

#3 ROSIE BEAR (E) (Stalker) Weakened to finish third after pressing the early leaders over the track and distance at this level in her latest last month in her first outing after a short break. Trainer Rodriguez wins with 18% of his claimers and has won with four of ten starters at this meet. Mare has won one of seven starts here and can be in good early position with Doyle remaining aboard.

#6 KONZA KHROME (U) (Stalker) Has not been seen since being claimed by Dale Bennett when defeating easier by over three lengths over five and a half furlongs at Hawthorne in January and has a record of 10-1-2-1 on this track. Bennett wins with 22% of his runners first off the claim and won with two of first eight starters at this meet. Mare can be forwardly placed from the start with Murrill in the saddle.

#7 CHECOTAH (E) (Presser) Was caught late after leading early when second as the favorite at this level over the track and distance in her latest last month. Four-year-old has won one of five starts on this Polytrack and trainer Silva wins with 21% of his runners that were beaten as the favorite last time out. Daughter of Denman can be running from just off the pace with Emigh retaining the mount.

#2 AVIATING (E) (Closer) Comes off a fourth-place finish in an even effort over the track and distance at this level last month. Four-year-old has won one of five starts here and trainer Inman won with one of first seven runners this meet. Dark bay should find a decent pace to close into with Felix in the irons.

#5 ODACHI (U) (Stalker) Second runner from the Silva barn weakened to finish third after pressing the early leader over the track and distance facing easier last month. Silva wins with 16% of his claimers and mare has won one of three starts on this track and can be near the front early but takes a fair class hike and loses previous rider Kennedy to the top choice.

RACE 3

#2 OH SO TALL (D) (Presser) Drops in class off a weakening fifth-place finish over at this distance after pressing the early leader in his latest last month in his first try on this track. Son of Portobello Road has won two of thirteen career starts and trainer Mason wins with 21% of her runners dropping two classes and with 15% of starters in claiming events. Gelding should be in good position from the start with Murrill retaining the mount.

#1 HE IS RUTHLESS (U) (Speed) Has not been seen since leading from the start to defeat easier over five furlongs at Hawthorne in early-April in his first start for trainer Perez. Five-year-old failed to hit the board in four previous starts on all-weather tracks but Perez wins with 18% of his runners that won last time out and with 18% of starters that have not raced for 46-90 days. Gray figures to be sent breaking from the rail with Cotto riding.

#5 KINSELLA (D) (Closer) Makes his first start on an all-weather track and has not been seen since finishing unplaced in an allowance over six furlongs at Mahoning in early-March. Son of Gio Ponti has won two of nine career starts and trainer Fiesman wins with 18% of runners that have not raced for 46-90 days. Son of Gio Ponti can be running late with Emigh taking the mount.

#4 CHARGE CARD (D) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced facing better over the track and distance last month in his first start after a short break. Trainer Winebaugh wins with 12% dropping two classes and with 13% of runners in claiming events. Dark bay has failed to hit the board in three starts on this track but can be a contender for a share at this level with Santiago in the saddle.

#6 KIELBASA (U) (Stalker) Has not been seen since fading to finish unplaced over a mile and a sixteenth facing easier here last July. Daughter of City Zip has failed to win in five starts here and trainer Cristel wins with just 6% of runners that have not raced for 90 days or more.

#3 BUCK SNORT (E) (Stalker) Makes his first start for trainer Perez after being eased at this level over seven furlongs at this level early last month. Perez wins with 14% of runners first time for his barn but gelding seems unlikely to find needed improvement to be a factor.

RACE 4

#1 ONE WAY HOME (D) (Speed) Gave way to finish unplaced over a mile and a sixteenth facing better after leading early in his latest last month and has won one of four starts at this distance. Trainer Perez wins with 17% of runners going from a route to a sprint and gelding has won one of six starts here. Four-year-old can be on or near the early lead under Emigh who won with three of last seven rides for Perez.

#3 RUN YOUR RACE (E) (Stalker) Was claimed by Mike Reavis when fading to finish sixth over the track and distance at this level in his latest last month in his second start after a short break. Son of Mizzen Mast has a record of 6-2-1-0 on this oval and Reavis wins with 276% of runners first off the claim and won with five of his first eleven starters this meet. Gray can be running from just off the pace with Marquez in the irons.

#5 MATCH PLAY (D) (Stalker) Drops in class off an unplaced effort over six and a half furlongs last month in his first start on this track and first since being claimed by Brian Williamson in April. Five-year-old is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and Williamson wins with 13% of his runners in claiming events. Dark bay can be forwardly placed early with Kennedy retaining the mount.

#6 BROAD BLUE LINE (U) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace to defeat easier over the track and distance in his latest last month in his second start on this track. Trainer Boyce wins with 20% of her runners that won last time out and has won with three of thirteen starters this meet. Dark bay can be running late with Cotto again in the saddle.

#2 HOMER (U) (Closer) Has not been seen since showing little facing easier over seven furlongs at Tampa in March. Six-year-old hit the board in two of three previous starts on this track and trainer Davis wins with 13% of runners in claiming events but bay has won just one of seventeen career outings and is likely best watched here.

#4 MAGICIAN'S BAGS (U) (Stalker) Weakened to finish fifth after chasing the early leaders facing better in his latest here last month. Five-year-old makes his second start for a low percentage barn and needs improvement to be a contender.

RACE 5

#8 ORCUS (U) (Closer) Main Track Only entrant rallied from off the pace to win his latest at this distance on the Polytrack last month winning his second start of the meet in his second outing after a three-month break. Seven-year-old has a record of 13-8-0-1 lifetime on all-weather tracks and trainer Rivelli wins with 32% of his runners third off a layoff and with 31% that won last time out. Bay appears the one to beat if this event is moved to the Polytrack.

#3 LETTHEBIGSHOT ROLL (U) (Closer) Has a record of 7-3-0-2 on this turf and has not been seen since closing from off the pace to narrowly miss when second over a mile at Fair Grounds in January. Son of Successful Appeal is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and trainer Roussel wins with 20% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days or more and with 18% of his starters on turf. Six-year-old can be running from off the pace with Felix in the irons.

#1 MOONLIGHT MISCHIEF (U) (Closer) Closed to finish second at this distance at Tampa in his latest in April and has won four of thirteen starts on this turf. Trainer Davis looks for her first winner of the year but wins with 16% of her starters on grass. Gelding can be a threat from off the pace with Murrill in the saddle.

#7 GOLDEN GIFT (E) (Stalker) Narrowly missed when second after being involved from the start at this level and distance on the main track here last month in his first start since February. Son of Lemon Drop Kid has a record of 8-3-3-1 on this turf and trainer Young wins with 12% of runners second off a layoff. Gelding can be in good position from the start with Doyle retaining the mount.

#2 MCHENRY (U) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace to win his latest at this distance on the Polytrack eleven days ago in his first start after a short break. Trainer Reavis wins with 21% of runners that won last time out and gelding has won two of eleven starts on this turf. Son of Henrythenavigator can be closing late with Marquez remaining aboard.

#4 BIG DINNER (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish fifth at this level and distance on the main track after pressing the early leaders last month. Gelding has won one of seven starts on this course and trainer Williamson wins with 11% of his starters on grass. Dark bay can be running late with Ulloa riding.

#6 ROCK N' CANDY (U) (Presser) Gets blinkers added off a fading unplaced effort over a mile on the main track at Churchill facing easier last month. Five-year-old has won one of three previous starts on turf and trainer Hiles has won with one of fourteen starters this year. Son of Twirling Candy may be sent early with Kennedy up.

#5 SUSPENDERS (U) (Closer) Was claimed by Fernando Bahena when never-threatening facing easier over seven furlongs on the main track here last month in his first start since December. Bahena won with one of last three runners first time off the claim and gelding has won three of fifteen starts on turf but has not won in a long time and takes on better here.

RACE 6

#3 HELEN HAYES (E) (Presser) Won her one previous start on this course and has not been seen since fading to finish fourth at this distance at Gulfstream in late-January. Daughter of Scat Daddy has a lifetime record of 5-1-0-2 on turf and trainer Rivelli wins with 32% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days or more. Four-year-old is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be in good position from the start with Felix in the irons.

#5 PAULETTE (D) (Stalker) Drops in class off a fading unplaced effort after dueling for the early lead at this distance on the main track last month. Filly failed to hit the board in four previous start on turf but has a decent pedigree for the surface and trainer Mitchell wins with 13% of his runners on grass. Four-year-old has tactical speed and can be forwardly placed early with Cotto remaining aboard.

#8 MY JILLY (D) (Closer) Closed to finish second over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track in her latest last month and won her one previous start on this turf. Trainer Stidham wins with 18% of his runners on grass and with 20% of his claimers. Daughter of Graydar can be running from off the pace with Doyle retaining the mount.

#7 PEACE LOVE BREAD (E) (Stalker) Tries turf for the first time off a fading unplaced effort over a mile and a sixteenth at Churchill last month in her first start since December. Filly should take to the surface being out of a mare by Gone West who has produced two winners on grass and trainer Manley wins with 10% of runners going from dirt to turf. Dark bay can be running late under Murrill who won with three of last seven rides for the barn.

#1 PRADO'S ENCORE (D) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track last month but hit the board in two of five previous starts on turf. Trainer Block wins with 17% of his claimers and daughter of Fort Prado can be near the front early under Lopez who won with three of last ten rides for this stable.

#2 SAMIS CAR (D) (Presser) Comes off a weakening fourth place finish after dueling for the early lead over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track last month in her first start after a short break. Dark bay failed to hit the board in four previous starts on turf but should be capable on the surface being by Data Link and out of a mare by Giant's Causeway. Trainer Winebaugh has won with 11% of runners this meet and filly can be on or near the early lead with Emigh riding.

#4 SUPERSTAR DIVA (E) (Stalker) Hit the board in two of four starts on this turf and may have needed her latest when fading over five and a half furlongs on the main track last month being her first outing since December. Trainer Zawitz has won with one of eight runners this meet and filly can be near the front early with Marquez in the saddle.

#6 SHEZ A QUEENIE (D) (Stalker) Has not been seen since fading early over six furlongs on dirt at Fairmount last July. Trainer Coontz won with one of last two runners that had not raced for 90 days or more but filly showed little in one previous try on turf and may be best watched today.

#9 SHES JUST CAPITAL (U) (Stalker) Faded to finish fourth after chasing the early leader over seven and a half furlongs facing easier on the main track last month. Daughter of Shanghai Bobby hit the board in both of two previous starts on this turf but is taking on tougher and barn has won with just 3% of runners this year.

#10 HERO ALEXANDRA (U) (Closer) Has not been seen since rallying from off the pace to break her maiden over a mile on the main track at Hawthorne in late-December. Trainer Bahena failed to win with last thirteen runners that had not raced for 90 days or more and filly was not a factor in one previous start on turf.

RACE 7

#4 VINCITORE (E) (Closer) Made progress from off the pace to finish third over a mile and a sixteenth in his latest at Fair Grounds in mid-January. Four-year-old won his one previous start on this turf and has been working sharply for trainer Roussel who wins with 20% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days or more. Son of 14% grass sire English Channel is out of a stakes placed mare and can be along from off the pace with Murrill riding.

#2 POWER SONG (E) (Speed) Faded to finish fifth over a mile and a sixteenth after leading early at this level on the main track last month in his first start after a short break. Trainer Robertson wins with 20% of his claimers and son of Eskendereya has a record of 6-1-1-2 on turf. Four-year-old may be the one to catch with Bridgmohan in the saddle.

#5 ALL AROUND (E) (Stalker) Tries grass for the first time off a closing fifth place finish over six furlongs in a starter allowance at Churchill last month in his fifth career start. Gelding has a decent pedigree for turf and trainer Manley has won with 27% of his runners so far at this meet. Bay is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be a threat under Emigh who won with four of his last eight rides for the barn.

#7 IOYA AGAIN (E) (Closer) Made progress to finish second over a mile and a sixteenth at this level on the main track in his latest last month in his first outing since November. Son of Fort Prado has a record of 4-1-1-1 on this turf and trainer Block wins with 9% of his runners second off a layoff. Gelding figures to be closing late with Marquez again in the saddle.

#6 AMERICANDY (D) (Closer) Is another trying turf for the first time and drops in class off a never-threatening unplaced effort facing better on the Polytrack last month in his first start after a short break. Trainer Stidham wins with 17% of his runners second off a layoff and with 16% first time on turf. Son of 13% turf sire can be a factor at this level with Kennedy aboard.

#8 BEHIND ENEMY LINES (D) (Closer) Drops into a claimer for the first time off a closing sixth place finish over a mile and a sixteenth at Hawthorne in November. Gray has won one of six starts on turf and trainer Block wins with 23% of his runners first time for a tag. Gelding can be running late but barn wins with a slightly low 9% of runners that have not raced for 90 days or more.

#3 LERO LERO (U) (Stalker) Takes on better off a weakening third place finish on the main track last month in his fourth career start and second after a short break. Trainer Davis wins with 16% of his claimers but son of Rule showed little in one previous start on turf.

#9 HONEST TO GOODNESS (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced at this level after a slow start on the main track in his latest last month. Son of Malibu Moon has a record of 5-1-1-2 on turf and can be trying to close with Felix in the irons.

#1 LEMON BLITZ (E) (Closer) Comes off a well-beaten fourth place finish at this level on the main track last month in his first start after being claimed by Chris Davis. Son of Lemon Drop Kid has won one of ten starts on turf and Davis wins with 16% of his claimers. Gelding can be running late but appears to need some improvement to be a serious threat.

RACE 8

#3 PRINCESS JULES (E) (Stalker) Was claimed by Alnaz Ali when rallying from just off the pace to win her latest over the track and distance at this level last month. Ali won with two of last twelve runners first off the claim and daughter of Fort Prado has won four of ten career starts. Gray is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be forwardly placed early with Emigh retaining the mount.

#5 LOOKTHEOTHERWAY (D) (Stalker) Comes off a weakening sixth place finish after chasing the early leaders over six furlongs facing better last month in her first start after a short break. Five-year-old has a record of 10-4-1-3 on this Polytrack and trainer Manley wins with 13% second off a layoff and has won with 27% of starters this meet. Mare can be in good position from the start under Murrill but does lose previous rider Emigh to the top choice.

#1 ALMAFUERTE (E) (Presser) Makes his first start for trainer Bigelow and first on an all-weather track off a fading fourth place finish over six furlongs at this level at Oaklawn in late-March. Daughter of Twirling Candy has won three of fifteen career starts and Bigelow won with one of first four runners this meet. Dark bay can be on or near the early lead breaking from the rail with Kennedy up.

#9 LUCKY AT JUSTICE (E) (Closer) Weakened to finish fourth when tried over a mile at this level in her latest last month but closed to finish second behind the top selection at this distance two back. Trainer Young wins with 15% of his claimers and daughter of Lookin at Lucky has a record of 7-1-2-1 on this Polytrack. Four-year-old can be a contender for a share running from off the pace with Lopez riding.

#2 GOOD WISHES (U) (Stalker) Was claimed by Mike Reavis when second after being involved from the start facing easier over the track and distance in her latest last month in her first start since early-December. Daughter of Congrats has hit the board in two of three starts here and Reavis wins with 26% of runners first off the claim. Mare can be near the front early with Marquez aboard.

#8 CONSTANCIA (E) (Stalker) Flattened out to finish third after making progress from just off the pace at this level and distance in her latest in first start on this oval. Trainer Merez wins with 17% of runners in claiming events and three-year-old can be in good early position with Santiago retaining the mount.

#6 RUNNING VICKY (U) (Closer) Second runner from the Bigelow barn closed from just off the pace when defeating easier over the track and distance last month in her first start since December. Bigelow wins with 21% of runners second off a layoff and gray has won two of four starts here but takes on tougher this time.

#4 HEY HEY (E) (Closer) Made some progress while a well-beaten fourth over the track and distance at this level last month. Trainer Candelas wins with 12% of her claimers but mare has not won in a long time and needs improvement on recent effort to be competitive.

#7 SOCIAL ICON (U) (Presser) Tries an all-weather track for the first time and was last seen when fading to finish unplaced facing easier over six furlongs at Oaklawn in early-April. Five-year-old makes his second outing for trainer Haran who wins with just 4% of runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and mare is likely a brief pace factor at best.

#3 GET NONE (D) (Speed) Gave way badly when unplaced over the track and distance after leading early facing better last month in her first start after a short break. Daughter of Biondetti has won one of three starts on this oval and trainer Rivelli wins with 30% of his runners second off a layoff and with 33% dropping two classes. Dark bay can be the one to catch under Valdivia who won with 39% of rides for Rivelli in the past two months.

#8 OLD FITZ (D) (Stalker) Drops into a maiden claimer for the first time in his turf debut and first start for trainer Davis off a second place finish over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track at Belterra last month in his second outing from which race the third place finisher won next out. Son of excellent turf sire Scat Daddy is out of a stakes winning mare who has produced two winners on grass and has been working well for trainer Davis who has won with 22% of his runners this meet. Gelding can be in good position from the start with Kennedy in the saddle.

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RACE 1

#6 LIVELY SPELL (D) (Speed) Weakened to finish second after dueling for the lead from the start over six furlongs in his latest last month in her first start on this track. Daughter of Live From Appollo has won one of six career starts for trainer Mason who wins with 15% of her claimers and who has won with 12% of runners this year. Filly appears to be fastest early under Felix who won with two of last ten rides for the barn.

#5 DANCE (E) (Closer) Comes off a second-place finish as the favorite after chasing the early leaders over six furlongs at this level at Hawthorne in April in her second start after a short break. Filly failed to hit the board in two previous starts on this Polytrack but trainer Brueggemann wins with 27% of his runners that were beaten as the favorite last time out and with 20% in claiming events. Filly can be running from off the pace into contention with Bridgmohan riding.

#1 TEMPLESIS (D) (Presser) Faded to finish a well-beaten third over the track and distance facing better last month in her first start since December. Daughter of Temple City has a record of 4-1-1-1 on this oval and trainer Wainwright wins with 8% of runners in claiming events. Mare can be forwardly placed early with Emigh remaining aboard.

#3 DIVA BANKER (D) (Presser) Was eased when facing better over six furlongs in his latest last month in his first start on this track and third overall. Trainer Robertson wins with 20% of his claimers and won with three of last nine runners dropping two classes. Dark bay can be in the early mix but loses previous rider Emigh.

#2 ANNIE TIME GIRL (D) (Closer) Has not been seen since finishing a distant fifth of six over six furlongs at Hawthorne facing tougher in early-April. Trainer Ryan has won with 15% of runners since the beginning of the year but filly managed just one third place finish from five previous tries on this track.

#4 WAZZ DAT (E) (Closer) Gets blinkers added after giving way badly when unplaced over a mile at Mahoning in April and will try an all-weather surface for the first time. Dark bay is trained by Robert Fiesman who wins with 18% of runners that have not raced for 46-90 days but mare seems unlikely to find the needed improvement to be a contender.

RACE 2

#3 GET NONE (D) (Speed) Gave way badly when unplaced over the track and distance after leading early facing better last month in her first start after a short break. Daughter of Biondetti has won one of three starts on this oval and trainer Rivelli wins with 30% of his runners second off a layoff and with 33% dropping two classes. Dark bay can be the one to catch under Valdivia who won with 39% of rides for Rivelli in the past two months.

#4 HONEY HEARTS (D) (Speed) Weakened to finish fourth after being sent early over the track and distance against slightly better in her latest last month in her first start for trainer Winebaugh and first on this Polytrack. Winebaugh wins with 13% of her claimers and has won with 11% of starters at this meet. Daughter of Gone Astay may not be quite as fast as the top selection but can be forwardly placed early with Kennedy remaining aboard.

#7 MISS DEVINE (E) (Stalker) Comes off a third-place finish after chasing the early leaders over six furlongs last month and has a record of 6-1-0-3 here. Daughter of Bold Warrior has a record of 8-1-2-1 on this oval and trainer Silva wins with 16% of runners in claiming races. Four-year-old can be trying to run late with Cotto in the irons.

#2 KINGSBURY DREAM (E) (Closer) Finished fourth in an even effort over six furlongs at this level last month in her second start after a short break. Four-year-old has won one of four starts on this track but trainer Childers has won with just 2% of runners since the beginning of the year.

#1 R FOUR O ONE K (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish fifth at this level over six furlongs here last month and has won one of nine starts on this track. Trainer Perez has won with 15% of his runners this year but mare has not won in a long time and needs improvement to be a contender.

#5 NUMBERS GAME (D) (Stalker) Gave way to finish unplaced over six furlongs facing tougher in her latest a week ago in her first start since last June. Five-year-old has failed to hit the board in four starts on this track and barn has failed to win with last ninety runners in claiming events.

RACE 3

#2 CROW MOON (D) (Closer) Has not been seen since showing little after a slow start in his debut over six furlongs on the main track in a maiden special weight event at Hawthorne in mid-December. Gelding should improve with the surface change being by 14% grass sire Artie Schiller and being a half-brother to one winner on turf and trainer Rivelli wins with 32% of runners that have not raced for 90 days or more. Three-year-old has been working forwardly and can be along from off the pace with Valdivia riding.

#5 CUP GAME (D) (Stalker) Was never a factor when unplaced at this distance on the main track last month in his first start since late-December and tries turf for the first time. Colt should take to the surface being by Kitten's Joy and out of a mare by Dynaformer and has hit the board in two of four career starts. Trainer Kozhomzharov has won with two of eight runners this meet and four-year-old can be forwardly placed early with Ulloa in the saddle.

#7 RICH TRADITION (D) (Closer) Is still a maiden after fourteen starts but has hit the board twelve times and drops in class off a never-threatening unplaced effort over a mile at Fair Grounds in late-January. Son of Pure Prize is a half brother to three winners and trainer Roussel wins with 20% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days or more. BRIS Prime Power choice has been working well and can be a threat with Emigh up.

#9 PEPPERMINT CRUNCH (D) (Presser) Hit the board in one of three previous starts on grass and comes off a weakening fourth place finish at this distance facing better on the main track here last month. Trainer Harty wins with 16% of his maiden claimers and daughter of Noble Mission is a half-brother to one winner. Gelding can be forwardly placed from the start with Doyle remaining aboard.

#10 HARLAN'S VADOR (E) (Closer) Finished second in one of two starts on grass and was prominent from the start when second at this level and distance on the main track last month in his second start after a short break. Son of Harlan's Holiday is out of a stakes winning mare who has produced one winner and trainer Korndenbrock wins with 17% of runners in maiden claiming events. Five-year-old can be running late with Kennedy riding.

#4 MAXIMUS IMAGE (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced in his debut at this level and distance on the main track in his debut last month. Son of 11% grass sire Langfuhr is a half-brother to one winner and trainer Smith has won with one of eleven runners this year. Gelding could show more here with Bridgmohan riding.

#6 TRES GENERACIONES (D) (Stalker) Tries grass and maiden claiming company for the first time off a fading fifth place finish over six and a half furlongs on the main track last month in his third career start. Trainer Meraz won with one of last three runners making this class drop and son of Northern Afleet can be a pace factor with Santiago retaining the mount.

#8 CAPTAIN CARNEGIE (D) (Stalker) Makes his first start for trainer Ryan off a fading unplaced effort after showing some early run at this distance on the main track last month in his fifth outing. Ryan wins with just 5% of his maiden claimers but has won with 15% of runners this year and gelding can be near the front early with Meza in the saddle.

#1 BORODINO (U) (Closer) Made mild belated progress when fifth over six furlongs on the main track early last month in his first outing and tries grass for the first time. Son of Bodemeister is out of a stakes winning mare but is unlikely to find the needed improvement to be a threat.

#3 OFF TO THE BEACH (E) (Stalker) Is a maiden after seventeen career starts and was never a factor when unplaced at this level on the main track over seven furlongs here last month. Bay hit the board in both of two previous starts on grass but barn has won with just 3% of runners this year.

RACE 4

#8 WEDDING BELLE (E) (Stalker) Tries an all-weather track for the first time and has not been seen since finishing second over five and a half furlongs at Indiana in mid-April in her second outing. Trainer West won with three of last twelve runners that had not raced for 46-90 days and daughter of Istan is a half-sister to five winners. Chestnut can get a good trip running from just off the pace with Felix in the saddle.

#2 SISTER RULER (E) (Presser) Was involved from the start when a close second in her debut over six furlongs here last month. Daughter of Road Ruler is a half-sister to three winners and trainer Manley wins with 15% of his second time starters and has won with 27% of his runners this meet. Dark bay can be in good position from the start under Murrill who won with three of last seven rides for the barn.

#7 FIELD DAISEY (E) (Speed) Weakened to finish sixth behind the top selection after leading early in her debut last month. Trainer Williamson wins with just 2% of his second time starters but daughter of Bold Warrior is a half sister to three winners and can be a threat with Lasix added.

#1 GLAMOUR GAL (1st Starter) Newcomer has a good win early pedigree being by 17% first out sire Goldcents and out of a mare by Unbridled's Song whose offspring win 13% of their first outings. Works include a solid five furlong move in 1:00 last month for trainer Davis who wins with 8% of his first-time starters and bay could be a factor with Doyle in the saddle.

#3 SUPER WONDER GIRL (1st Starter) Trainer Williamson wins with 12% of his first-time starters and saddles debuting daughter of 16% first out sire Daaher who is a half-sister to five winners. Filly's works include a decent five furlong move in 1:01 1/5 here last month for Williamson who wins with 11% of his runners in maiden special weight events. Three-year-old could be a threat with Ulloa riding.

#9 BONITA BAY (E) (Stalker) Second runner from the Davis barn tries this surface for the first time and was not a factor when unplaced on turf over a mile at Fair Grounds in his latest in January. Daughter of Bernardini is a half-sister to five winners and posted a five-furlong work in 1:00 nine days ago for Davis who wins with 21% of runners that have not raced for 90 days or more. Filly could show more here with Kennedy aboard.

#6 TIZALADYBUG (E) (Presser) Weakened to finish second at this distance at Prairie Meadows in her latest early last month and has hit the board in both of two starts. Trainer Hunkapiller is looking for first winner this year but daughter of Tizway is out of a stakes winning mare and can be forwardly placed early with Meza up.

#5 NURSE SADIE (E) (Stalker) Made progress to finish fourth over the track and distance in her latest in her first start since October and third outing overall. Daughter of Foreclosed showed early speed in her first two starts and makes her first outing for trainer Pompell who wins with 12% of his maiden claimers. Chestnut can be running from just off the pace with Santiago retaining the mount.

#4 LADY DI (E) (Closer) Second runner from the Pompell barn was never a factor when unplaced in her debut over five and a half furlongs here last-August. Pompell wins with 8% of runners that have not raced for 90 days or more and filly has worked well enough but is still likely to need this outing.

RACE 5

#5 MOON OVER MONTANA (E) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace to win his latest at this distance on the main track here last month in his first start since being reclaimed by Larry Rivelli here in September. Son of Spring at Last has won one of three starts on this turf and Rivelli wins with 30% of his runners second off a layoff and with 31% of starters that won last time out. Five-year-old can be in good position from the start with Valdivia remaining aboard.

#1 CAMMACK (E) (Closer) Comes off a closing second place finish as the favorite at this level and distance last month in his first start after a short break. Son of Giant's Causeway has a record of 15-7-2-0 on this course and trainer Block wins with 27% of his runners that were beaten as the favorite last time out and with 15% of starters on turf. Dark bay can be running late under Lopez who won with three of last ten rides for the barn.

#2 BLUE SKY KOWBOY (D) (Closer) Has not been seen since closing some to finish fourth in a stakes at this distance across town last-October. Chestnut has won three of nine starts on this turf and trainer Boyce wins with 16% of runners that have not raced for 90 days or more. Gelding is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be running late but did need an outing before winning at the beginning of last year.

#3 MEMORY BANK (E) (Closer) Has a record of 6-1-2-2 on this course and has not been seen since closing to finish third at this distance at Fair Grounds in January. Trainer Stidham wins with 18% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days or more and five-year-old was competitive with many of today's rivals here last summer. Chestnut can be a factor from off the pace with Murrill retaining the mount.

#8 CHRISTAIN C (E) (Presser) Was last seen when weakening to finish third over the course and distance after leading early as the favorite last August and has a record of 10-4-2-1 lifetime on turf. Six-year-old has won four of eight starts on this turf and trainer Catalano wins with 16% of runners that have not raced for three months or more. Gelding may be the one to catch with Santiago in the saddle.

#11 MISSPENT YOUTH (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced over a mile at Keeneland in his latest in early-April and has won two of eleven career starts on turf. Son of Exchange Rate is trained by Ben Colebrook who wins with 11% of runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and gelding can be near the front early with Bridgmohan riding.

#9 CUESTION DE TIEMPO (E) (Presser) Weakened to finish fifth over a mile at Keeneland after dueling for the early lead in his latest in April and has a record of 2-1-0-1 on this turf. Trainer Correas wins with 13% of his runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and gelding finished third over the course and distance in the Grade Three Arlington Classic last year. Son of The Factor can be forwardly placed from the start with Herrera aboard.

#7 SURF SHACK (U) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace before drawing off to defeat easier by seven lengths on the Polytrack at this distance in his latest last month. Dark bay failed to win in nine career starts on grass but trainer Winebaugh wins with 13% that won last time out and gelding could be a threat if this event is moved to the main track over which he has a record of 4-2-1-0.

#10 GOLDEN DRAGON (D) (Closer) Won one of three previous starts on this turf and drops in class off a fading unplaced effort in a Grade Two at Gulfstream over eleven furlongs in early-March. Trainer Yanakov wins with just 6% of runners that have not raced for 90 days or more and colt has not won in a long time.

#4 BULLDOG OF BERGEN (E) (Closer) Finished well when a close second over six furlongs on the main track in his latest here last month and will try turf for the first time. Gelding has a decent enough pedigree for grass but comes from a low percentage turf barn and seems unlikely to find needed improvement to be a contender.

#6 CHIEF OAKIE DOKIE (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced on the main track at this level and distance in his latest last month in his first start of the year. Trainer Coontz is looking for first winner of the year and gelding failed to hit the board in two previous tries on grass.

RACE 6

#4 OHMYMY (E) (Stalker) Has not been seen since flattening out to finish second after making some progress from just off the pace at this level and distance on the all-weather surface at Turfway in March in her third career outing. Daughter of Monarchos is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and trainer West won with three of last twelve runners that had not raced for 46-90 days. Filly can be running from just off the pace with Doyle riding.

#3 KENAI COOL (E) (Presser) Was prominent from the start when second as the favorite at this level over five and a half furlongs here last month. Filly has now hit the board in both of two starts on this Polytrack and trainer Rodriguez wins with 22% of his runners that were beaten as the favorite last time out. Daughter of Shanghai Bobby is a half-sister to two winners and can be on or near the early lead with Emigh remaining aboard.

#8 THIRSTY COWGIRL (E) (Closer) Made belated progress to finish fourth over five and a half furlongs at this level last month and has hit the board in one of two starts here. Trainer Young wins with 9% of runners in maiden claiming events and filly can be running late with Felix retaining the mount.

#6 LADY ATLANTIC (D) (Presser) Makes her first start for trainer Reavis and has not been seen since weakening to finish sixth after dueling for the early lead over a mile facing better on grass here last July in her second career start. Reavis wins with 25% of runners that have not raced for 90 days and daughter of Stormy Atlantic can be in the early mix under Marquez who won with ten of last twenty rides for the barn.

#7 ALL THE THINGS (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced at this distance at Oaklawn in her latest early this month and will try an all-weather track for the first time. Daughter of Early Flyer has hit the board in one of six start and trainer Hartman wins with 16% of his maiden claimers but filly needs to improve on recent efforts to be competitive.

#10 SHARPERTHANME (E) (Closer) Never-threatened when unplaced over five and a half furlongs at this level in her latest last month in her first start on this track. Trainer Davis wins with 15% of her maiden claimers but filly's last try does not inspire confidence.

#5 DANCE LIKE KATIE (E) (Closer) Gave way to finish unplaced over the track and distance at this level in her latest last month. Five-year-old has now failed to win in five starts on this oval and trainer Delong wins with just 4% of runners on all-weather tracks.

#9 PRETTY SWEET CHICF (U) (Stalker) Showed some early run before fading to finish unplaced over the track and distance facing easier last month in her third career start and second outing of the year. Trainer Ryan wins with just 5% of maiden claimers and mare could be a brief pace factor with Meza up.

#2 HERO OF GOLD (1st Starter) Newcomer by Hero of Order is a half-sister to one winner and debuts for trainer Dorochenko who won with one of first twelve runners this meet. Dark bay has posted a couple of decent works but barn wins with just 3% of first-time starters and filly is likely to need this outing.

#1 SOUTHERN ATTACK (D) (Closer) Has not been seen since showing little in a maiden special weight event over five and a half furlongs here last July in her second outing. Three-year-old drops into a maiden claimer for the first time but trainer Childers failed to win with last thirty-seven runners that had not raced for 90 days or more and bay is best watched here.

RACE 7

#2 GHAALEB'S APPEAL (U) (Stalker) Finished second in one previous start on this track and comes off a win from just off the pace over five furlongs at Fairmount early last month in her second start of the year. Four-year-old has won three of eight career starts and posted a sharp four-furlong work in 47 1/5 here last month for trainer Becker who wins with 36% third off a layoff and with 32% that won last time out. Filly can be in good early position under Emigh who won with 25% of rides for the barn in the past two months.

#10 JOYFUL NIGHT (U) (Presser) Led from the start before drawing off to break her maiden by eleven lengths over the track and distance in her latest last month in her first start on this oval and third overall. Daughter of Midnight Lute is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and trainer Block wins with 20% of runners that broke their maiden last time out. Dark bay gives up and experience edge to most here but can be forwardly placed from the start with Lopez remaining aboard.

#7 OOOCHIE (D) (Stalker) Makes her first start for trainer Amoss and drops in class off a fourth-place finish in an even effort at this distance at Oaklawn early last month. Three-year-old has won one of four starts and tries an all-weather track for the first time for Amoss who has won with three of nine runners this meet. Bay can be near the front throughout under Bridgmohan who won with two of last nine rides for the barn.

#4 FIREWATER ROCKET (U) (Presser) Comes off a gate-to-wire win over easier over five and a half furlongs at Oaklawn in April and will try an all-weather surface for the first time. Trainer Gorder wins with 14% of runners that won last time out and filly has won two of ten career starts. Daughter of Macho Rocket can be near the front early with Valdivia taking the mount.

#8 REGAL SERENADE (E) (Closer) Flattened out to finish second as the favorite after making progress from off the pace over a mile and a sixteenth at this level in her latest last month in her first start since being claimed by Wayne Catalano in March. Catalano wins with 23% of his runners third off a layoff and daughter of Broken Vow can be running late with Marquez retaining the mount.

#9 RAKE IT UP (E) (Presser) Comes off a fading fourth place finish over a mile and a sixteenth after leading early at this level last month and has a record of 6-1-1-1 on this Polytrack. Trainer Rodriguez wins with 13% of his runners in allowance events and filly can be in the early mix with Felix again in the saddle.

#3 MEEKA (E) (Presser) Weakened to finish third after pressing the early pace over five and a half furlongs last month in her second start of the year and has hit the board in two of four starts here. Trainer Manley wins with 19% of his runners third off a layoff and has won with 27% of starters at this meet. Four-year-old can be in good early position but does lose previous rider Emigh to the top choice.

#6 MARIA'S MOMENT (U) (Presser) Comes off a second-place finish after dueling for the early lead over the track and distance last month in his first outing since last August. Bay has won one of three starts here and trainer Kirby has won with 20% of runners this meet and filly can be a pace factor under Kennedy who won with two of last five rides for the barn.

#5 LAUNCH AWAY (U) (Closer) Made progress to finish fourth over the track and distance in her latest last month in her first start since being claimed by Manny Perez. Barn wins with 21% second off the claim and mare could show more but does lose previous rider Felix and has won just two of thirty-two career starts.

#1 SHARING A LAUGH (U) (Closer) Rallied from just off the pace to defeat easier over seven and a half furlongs last month in her first start since being claimed by Patti Miller last-November. Gray has now won two of three starts on this oval but Miller wins with just 4% that won last time out and gray takes a fair class hike here.

RACE 8

#8 OLD FITZ (D) (Stalker) Drops into a maiden claimer for the first time in his turf debut and first start for trainer Davis off a second place finish over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track at Belterra last month in his second outing from which race the third place finisher won next out. Son of excellent turf sire Scat Daddy is out of a stakes winning mare who has produced two winners on grass and has been working well for trainer Davis who has won with 22% of his runners this meet. Gelding can be in good position from the start with Kennedy in the saddle.

#3 RONAMO (D) (Closer) Comes off a third-place finish in an even effort over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track in a maiden special weight event last month. Three-year-old has hit the board in five of seven career starts and trainer Catalano wins with 17% of runners making this class drop and with 16% of starters on turf. Son of Run Away and Hide is a half-brother to one winner on grass and can be a threat with Marquez aboard.

#6 JUAN PABLO (E) (Closer) Made some progress to finish third over a mile and a sixteenth at this level on the main track last month in his first start after a short break. Son of Street Sense is a half-brother to one winner on grass and has hit the board in two of four starts on turf for trainer Harty who wins with 16% of his maiden claimers. Three-year-old can be running late with Valdivia retaining the mount.

#7 HERO OF THE HOUR (E) (Closer) Has not been seen since closing to narrowly miss when second over a mile and a sixteenth at this level at Fair Grounds in mid-March and has hit the board in three of five starts on turf. Trainer Roussel wins with 17% of his runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and son of City Zip can be running late with Murrill again in the saddle.

#4 KALININGRAD (D) (Closer) Is still a maiden after twenty tries but has hit the board in five of sixteen starts on grass and has not been seen since finishing third in an even effort on the main track at Hawthorne in mid-April. Son of English Channel is a half-brother to five winners and trainer Kozhomzharov who won with two of last seven runners that had not raced for 46-90 days. Dark bay can be closing from off the pace under Felix who won with three of last ten rides for the barn.

#1 HARD STORY (D) (Closer) Tries maiden claiming company for the first time and has not been seen since finishing fifth in an even effort at this distance at Tampa in April in his second outing. Son of 13% grass sire Hard Spun is out of a stakes winning mare and trainer Correas wins with 23% of his runners making this class drop. Bay can be a factor with Emigh taking the mount.

#2 TAPIZART (D) (Closer) Makes his turf debut off a well-beaten fourth place finish across town in April in his third career start. Trainer Cowan wins with 10% of runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and son of Tapizar is a half-brother to one winner on grass. Chestnut may show more here with blinkers added and with Lopez up.

#9 RUSTIC RICK (E) (Stalker) Weakened to finish fourth after chasing the early leader over five and a half furlongs on this turf at this level last month in his third career start. Trainer Williamson wins with 11% of his runners on grass and dark bay can be in good early position with Ulloa aboard.

#11 WHAT A HOOT (U) (Closer) Second runner from the Correas barn has not been seen since closing to finish second over a mile and a sixteenth facing easier at Tampa in late-March. Son of Data Link has hit the board in four of seven starts on grass and Correas has won with two of sixteen runners this meet. Gelding can be trying to close late with Herrera up.

#10 CANARY ISLANDS (E) (Stalker) Tries turf for the first time off a fading fifth of six place finish over five and a half furlongs on the Polytrack last month in his second outing. Gray gets blinkers added and has a decent pedigree for turf but barn has won with just 5% of runners this year.

#5 TORNADO BOY (1st Starter) Newcomer by Drosselmeyer debuts for trainer Dorochenko who wins with just 3% of his first-time starters. Dark bay's works are nothing special and may just need his first outing.

#9 SUMMER LEGACY (U) (Stalker) Has not been seen since fading to finish sixth on the main track at Hawthorne in November. Trainer Block wins with 9% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days or more and gray has a decent record of 10-3-0-2 on this turf.

#4 WORKINGFORALIVING (E) (Stalker) Has not been seen since fading to finish unplaced at this distance at Fair Grounds in early-January and won one of three previous starts on this turf. Trainer Brueggemann wins with 20% of his claimers and gelding can be forwardly placed early with Emigh in the irons.

#6 HIGH ON SUGAR (E) (Closer) Narrowly missed when closing to finish second at this level on the main track in his latest last month. Barn wins with just 3% of runners making this surface change but gelding has won one of eight starts on this course and can be running late with Murrill taking the mount.

#2 JIMMY D (E) (Closer) Has a record of 14-2-2-1 on turf and comes off a closing third place finish on the main track at this level last month. Four-year-old is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power but makes his second start for trainer Hughes who has won with just 3% of runners this year.

#1 GOOD INTENT (E) (Stalker) Weakened to finish fourth after leading early on the main track here last month in his second start after a short break. Gelding can be forwardly placed early but failed to hit the board in two previous starts on this turf and barn wins with just 3% on grass.

#11 ANDREW THE GIANT (D) (Closer) Drops in class off a never-threatening unplaced effort over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track early last month. Four-year-old could be more competitive at this level but comes from a low percentage turf barn and failed to hit the board in two starts on this turf.

#3 CONTRACTION (U) (Presser) Led from the start to defeat easier over seven furlongs on the main track in his latest last month. Son of Speightstown has won one of eight career starts on grass but is likely just a brief pace factor at this level.

#7 MAXUS (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track in his latest early last month. Trainer Perez wins with just 6% of starters on turf and gelding needs improvement on last few starts to be a contender.

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RACE 1

#3 DAVKA (D) (Stalker) Takes a drop in class off a fading unplaced effort in an allowance over a mile eight days ago in his first start on this oval. Son of Alternation has a lifetime record of 11-3-1-2 on all-weather tracks and trainer Mason wins with 11% of runners going from a route to a sprint and with 15% in claiming events. Gelding can be along from off the pace under Felix who won with two of last ten rides for the barn.

#1 WORD OF TRUTH (U) (Closer) Rallied from just off the pace to win his latest over five and a half furlongs last month in his first start since December. Trainer Kirby wins with 20% of his claimers that won last time out and son of Forestry has a record of 4-2-1-0 on this oval. Five-year-old can be a threat with Santiago retaining the mount.

#7 TEE TEE (E) (Stalker) Comes off a closing second place finish at this level over five and a half furlongs at Indiana last month and has a record of 7-2-1-1 on synthetic tracks. Trainer Wittek wins with 15% of runners in claiming events and son of Blame can be stalking the early leaders with Emigh up.

#4 A J'S POSSE (U) (Stalker) Was not a factor when unplaced over five and a half furlongs in his latest last month and has hit the board in two of eight starts on this oval. Gelding is trained by David Reid who wins with 17% of his claimers and bay can be forwardly placed early with Marquez in the irons.

#5 FLAT OUT FAST (E) (Closer) Tries this oval for the first time off a never-threatening unplaced effort at this level over seven furlongs at Churchill last month in first start after a short break. Trainer Glyshaw wins with 13% of runners second off a layoff but latest outing does not offer encouragement.

#6 SMOKEY ROW MAC (U) (Closer) Made some progress to finish third over seven furlongs facing easier in his latest last month. Chestnut has won two of nineteen starts on this oval but trainer Hughes has won with just 3% of runners since the beginning of the year.

#2 KYZAN (U) (Closer) Second runner from the Hughes barn has a record of 16-3-5-1 on this Poly-track but comes off a never-threatening unplaced effort over five and a half furlongs facing easier here last month. Gelding needed improvement on that outing to be a factor.

RACE 2

#3 OUR THOMAS (D) (Closer) Comes off a fourth-place finish in an even effort in an allowance over the track and distance last month in his second start since being claimed by Larry Rivelli. Son of Dublin has a record of 10-2-1-3 on this track and Rivelli wins with 30% of his claimers and has won with 44% of runners at this meet. Gelding is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be along from off the pace with Valdivia remaining aboard.

#4 OHIO PLAYER (D) (Speed) Stablemate of the top choice led from the start to win his latest over five and a half furlongs at Thistledowns last month and has won three of twelve career outings. Gray failed to hit the board in two previous starts on all-weather tracks but Rivelli wins with 31% of his runners that won last time out. Son of Alphabet Soup figures to be the one to catch under Cotto in his first start facing claiming company.

#2 P R RADIO STAR (U) (Closer) Was prominent from the start when defeating easier over the track and distance last month in his first start after a short break and has a record of 7-1-0-3 on this oval. Trainer Swearingen has won with three of thirteen starters this meet and wins with 18% of runners that won last time out. Bay can be a factor from off the pace with Emigh retaining the mount.

#1 NEW DANCER (D) (Stalker) Was not a factor when unplaced in an allowance over six and a half furlongs last month in his first start on this oval and second after being claimed by Ingrid Mason. Five-year-old has won three of sixteen career starts and Mason wins with 15% of her runners in claiming events. Bay has some tactical speed and can be in good position throughout with Felix riding.

#5 GREY MASK (D) (Presser) Has not been seen since fading to finish unplaced in an allowance at this distance at Hawthorne in April. Gray has hit the board on one of two previous starts here and trainer Slager wins with 16% of runners that have not raced for 46-90 days. Son of Leroidesanimaux can be forwardly placed from the start with Doyle aboard.

#6 TRAPPE VALLEY (E) (Stalker) Comes off a closing second place finish over five furlongs last month in his first start on this track and first for trainer Vanden Berg. Barn is looking for first winner but gelding has tactical speed and has won one of eight starts overall on all-weather tracks. Bay is not without chances but does lose previous rider Emigh to another in here.

RACE 3

#6 CLEAR N CONVINCING (D) (Stalker) Tries claiming company for the first time and has not been seen since fading to finish unplaced after being involved early at this distance at Kentucky Downs last September in his second start for trainer Rivelli. Son of Giant's Causeway has a record of 5-2-0-1 lifetime on turf and won his one previous start on this course for Rivelli who wins with 32% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days or more and with 26% first time for a tag. Dark bay can be in good position from the start with Valdivia in the saddle.

#2 TIZ SAMURAI (D) (Speed) Comes off a weakening third place finish after dueling for the early lead as the favorite in an allowance over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track early last month. Gelding has hit the board in three of six previous starts on grass and trainer Boyce wins with 30% of runners that were beaten as the favorite last time out and with 15% of her claimers. Son of First Samurai may be the one to catch with Marquez remaining aboard.

#4 HE'S CHEEKY (E) (Closer) Second runner from the Rivelli barn has won two of ten career starts on turf and comes off a closing second place finish over a mile and a sixteenth last month in his first start after a long break. Rivelli wins with 30% of his runners second off a layoff and with 30% of his starters in claiming events. Gray can be running late but does lose previous rider Valdivia to the top selection.

#3 RHYTHMIA (E) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace to win at this distance at Tampa in his latest in late-April in his second start after a short break. Trainer Bennett wins with 21% of his runners that won last time out and son of Majestic Warrior has a record of 6-3-2-0 lifetime on grass. Bay can be in good position from the start under Felix who won with one of last three rides for the barn.

#8 TWO PAIR (D) (Stalker) Comes off a fading fourth place finish in an allowance over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track here last month. Gelding won one of three previous starts on turf and trainer Swearingen wins with 15% of his claimers and has won with three of thirteen runners this meet. Dark bay can be running from off the pace with Bridgmohan in the irons.

#1 DELTA LEVY (E) (Closer) Finished fourth in an even effort over a mile and a sixteenth at this level on the main track last month and finished second in one previous start on this turf. Trainer Granitz wins with 16% of his runners on grass and with 16% in claiming events and chestnut can be trying to close late with Murrill up.

#5 MIRACLE MOUNTAIN (U) (Closer) Was claimed by Vanden Berg when rallying from just off the pace to defeat easier over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track last month in his first start since March. Son of Kitten's Joy has hit the board in two of three previous starts on this turf and should not be far off the early pace under Emigh but does take on better here.

#7 ZANFORCE (E) (Stalker) Won one of three previous starts on this turf and comes off a fading unplaced effort over a mile and a sixteenth at this level on the main track last month. Trainer Wilson wins with just 6% of runners on turf and gelding may be just a brief pace factor again with Doyle retaining the mount.

RACE 4

#6 EMBARRASSING (U) (Presser) Has not been seen since leading from the start to defeat easier over a mile and a sixteenth at Hawthorne in October and has won three of six career starts on turf. Daughter of Fort Prado has won two of four starts on this course for trainer Block who wins with 15% of runners on grass and who has won with 29% at this meet. Filly takes on tougher but could surprise on the front end under Lopez who won with three of last ten rides for the barn.

#3 MO'S M V P (E) (Stalker) Chased the talented Daddy's Boo when second over a mile and a sixteenth at this level in her latest on the main track last month in her first outing since March and second of the year. Daughter of Uncle Mo has a record of 5-1-2-0 on this turf and trainer Campbell has won with one of first eight runners this meet. Five-year-old has tactical speed and can be in good position from the start with Murrill retaining the mount.

#1 OH SO TERRIBLE (E) (Closer) BRIS Prime Power choice gets blinkers added off a closing third place finish behind the top choice over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track last month in her second start of the year. Trainer Ross won with one of last two runners third off a layoff and daughter of Cape Blanco has won two of five starts on this turf. Mare can be running from off the pace with Valdivia riding.

#6 STROLLIN THE BAYOU (E) (Closer) May have just needed her latest when unplaced on the main track in her latest over a mile and a sixteenth last month behind others that return here being her first start since September. Daughter of Stroll has won one of two starts on grass and trainer Block wins with 9% of runners second off a layoff. Dark bay can show more here with Marquez remaining aboard.

#8 DRINKS ON ME (E) (Closer) Faded to finish a well-beaten fifth over a mile and a sixteenth at this level on the main track last month in her second start after a short break. Trainer Winebaugh wins with 10% of runners making this surface change and daughter of Stay Thirsty finished fourth in a stakes on grass at Indiana last year. Four-year-old can show more back on turf with Perez aboard.

#2 FIZZY FRIDAY (E) (Closer) Was eased after stumbling in her latest facing the top two choices in her latest on the main track last month but has won two of fifteen starts on grass. Trainer Correas wins with 11% of his runners on turf and daughter of Royal Applause was stakes placed on the all-weather surface at Golden Gates last year. Five-year-old can be trying to close late with Felix in the irons.

#4 ROYAL'S POSITION (E) (Stalker) Gave way to finish unplaced over six furlongs on the main track at this level in her latest last month in her second start of the year. Daughter of Well Positioned failed to hit the board in one previous start on turf but trainer Becker wins with 36% third off a layoff and filly can be in the early mix with Emigh up.

#5 IMA LITTLE KITTEN (E) (Closer) Has not been seen since showing little at this level over six and a half furlongs on the main track at Hawthorne in her latest in April. Six-year-old has won one of nine starts on this turf but barn failed to win with last thirteen runners that had not raced for 46-90 days and wins with just 6% of runners on grass.

RACE 5

#7 WELLFIELD (D) (Closer) Finished fourth in one previous start on an all-weather track and drops in class off a never-threatening unplaced effort over six furlongs at Churchill last month. Son of The Factor is ranked first on BRIS Current Class and trainer McKeever wins with 16% of runners in maiden claiming events. Gray can be tough at this level with Kennedy riding.

#5 SERTOMAN (D) (Stalker) Gets blinkers added for his first start for trainer Catalano off a fading unplaced effort facing better over a mile at Churchill last month in his second start of the year and fourth outing overall. Catalano has won with 14% of his runners this meet and son of Paynter is out of a stakes winning mare who has produced six winners. Dark bay can be near the front from the start with Perez in the saddle.

#1 ROUL THE ICE (D) (Closer) Earned top ranking on BRIS Speed Last Race when a well-beaten fifth over a mile and a sixteenth facing better here last month in his fourth career outing and first on this track. Son of Ice Box is a half-brother to two winners and is also first on Prime Power but trainer Haran wins with few runners on all-weather tracks.

#4 JOHNNY CHADDA (D) (Stalker) Second runner from the Haran barn comes off a distant fourth place finish over seven furlongs facing better last month in his first start on this track. Haran wins with 11% of runners dropping two classes and gelding can be near the front early with Felix retaining the mount.

#6 SONERO (D) (Closer) Makes his first outing for trainer Ali and has not been seen since showing little facing better over seven furlongs at Tampa in March in his third outing. Son of Tale of the Cat is a half brother to two winners and may show more for Ali who wins with 14% of runner first time for his barn.

#8 MUSICAL INTEREST (D) (Stalker) Comes off a distant fifth place finish over seven furlongs facing better last month in his first start on this oval and first outing since March. Trainer Candelas has won with one of nine starters this meet and gelding can be forwardly placed early with Marquez remaining aboard.

#3 PRINCE ATTACK (E) (Stalker) Gave way badly when last of five over six furlongs at this level in his latest last month in his second start of the year. Barn wins with just 3% of runners third off a layoff and gelding has failed to defeat a rival in three career outings.

#2 MUSKET HUNTER (E) (Closer) Was not a threat when unplaced at this level over six furlongs here last month and has now failed to win in twenty-seven career starts. Trainer Perez wins with 12% of runners in maiden claiming events but gray has failed in many chances.

RACE 6

#9 RIV (E) (Presser) Rallied from just off the pace to win his latest at this distance on the main track last month and won his one previous start on this turf. Son of 13% grass sire Iqbaal is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and Current Class and trainer Rodriguez wins with 13% of runners that won last time out. Gelding can be in good position from the start with Felix retaining the mount.

#4 MINI MILES (U) (Speed) Has a record of 5-1-1-0 on turf and comes off a gate-to-wire near seven length win over six furlongs on dirt at Indiana last month. Trainer Lauer wins with 13% of runners that won last time out and has won with 10% of starters at this meet. Son of Maclean's Music may be sent early and part of a fast pace with Valdivia in the saddle.

#6 SHANGHAI POINT (E) (Presser) Comes off a third-place finish behind the top selection after a rough trip on the main track last month in his first start for trainer Vanden Berg. Son of Shanghai Bobby finished second in one previous start on grass and both of barn's two runners this meet hit the board. Dark bay has speed and can be in good position from the start with Molina riding.

#3 GO VO (E) (Stalker) Closed to finish second at this level and distance on the Polytrack in his latest last month. Gelding has won one of five starts on turf and trainer Manley wins with 12% of runners making this surface change. Seven-year-old can be stalking the early leaders with Santiago retaining the mount.

#2 JIVE DADDY (E) (Stalker) Second runner from the Manley barn faded to finish unplace behind his stablemate in his latest last month in his second start of the year. Son of Scat Daddy has a record of 21-5-2-2 on turf and may be more competitive third off a layoff and returning to this surface.

#10 M C SQUARED (U) (Closer) Has not been seen since finishing third in an even effort facing easier at this distance at Hawthorne in April. Trainer Rodriguez has won with 14% of his runners at this meet and gelding has won seven of twenty-eight career starts on turf. Chestnut can be running late with Emigh aboard.

#5 RIVZINTHEHOUSE (E) (Speed) Gave way to finish unplaced behind others that return here after dueling for the early lead in his latest on the main track. Dark bay makes his second start since being claimed by Spanabel who is looking for first winner of the year but gelding has won three of seven starts here and will likely be sent to the early lead.

#8 GRAY MENSCH (E) (Speed) Faded to finish fifth after setting pressured early fractions at this distance on the main track last month in second start of the year. Trainer Ryan wins with 13% of runners third off a layoff and gray can be in the early mix but has won just one of twenty-five starts on this turf.

#1 BOSTON CHARLEY (U) (Speed) Faded to finish sixth after leading early over five and a half furlongs on dirt at Hawthorne in his latest in early-December. Son of decent turf sprint sire Rocky Bar has own two of twelve starts on turf and trainer Aguilar wins with 13% that have not raced for 90 days or more but dark bay is likely just a brief pace factor.

#7 AMAROQ (U) (Stalker) Makes his first start for trainer McCanick and has not been seen since closing from just off the pace to defeat easier on dirt at Hawthorne in early-December. Gelding has been working well but failed to win in five previous starts on turf and takes on better for barn looking for first winner of year.

RACE 7

#5 BURNSIDE (E) (Stalker) Likely needed his latest when fading to finish fifth after leading early despite a poor break over a mile and a sixteenth at this level last month being his first start in nearly twenty months. Son of excellent turf sire War Front is a half brother to three stakes winners including Grade One placed on grass Closing Bell and has won one of two starts on turf for trainer Rivelli who wins with 30% of his runners second off a layoff. Four-year-old is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be near the front early with blinkers added and with Valdivia remaining aboard.

#7 BIRDSNEST PARTY (E) (Speed) Weakened to finish a close fourth after leading early at this distance at Tampa in his latest in mid-April and has won four of fifteen career starts on grass. Trainer Stidham wins with 17% of his runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and with 18% of his starters on turf. Five-year-old can be on or near the early lead with Murrill retaining the mount.

#1 FASHION DECREE (U) (Closer) Closed from off the pace to win his latest over a mile and a sixteenth defeating easier on the main track last month. Son of Speightstown won one of two previous starts on grass for trainer Correas who wins with 14% of his runners that won last time out. Gelding can be running late into contention with Kennedy again in the saddle.

#6 PONT DU GARD (U) (Closer) Has not been seen since rallying from just off the pace to win his latest over seven and a half furlongs at Fair Grounds in early-March. Four-year-old has a record of 12-3-2-0 lifetime on grass and makes his fourth outing for trainer Roussel who wins with 20% of his runners that have not raced for 90 days or more. Colt has been working well and can be a contender for a share with Lopez up.

#9 FARAT (E) (Closer) Made some belated progress when a non-threatening sixth over a mile and a sixteenth at Keeneland in his latest in April. Son of Lemon Drop Kid finished second in one of two starts on this turf and makes his second outing for trainer Kozhomzharov who won with two of last seven runners that had not raced for 46-90 days. Dark bay can be running late under Marquez who won with his latest ride for the barn.

#4 CAVE RUN (E) (Stalker) Comes off a fourth-place finish in an even effort over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track last month in his first start since February and tries turf for the first time. Son of Street Sense is a half-brother to one winner on grass and trainer Harty wins with 12% second off a layoff. Three-year-old can be running from just off the pace with Doyle again in the saddle.

#2 SAILING SOLO (E) (Closer) Comes off a well-beaten third place finish over a mile and a sixteenth here last month and has won one of six career outings. Four-year-old failed to hit the board in two previous starts on grass but has a good pedigree for the surface and trainer Roussel wins with 18% of his runners on turf. Chestnut can be trying to close late under Emigh who won with one of last two rides for Roussel.

#10 HERO TIGER (E) (Stalker) Comes off a second placed finish after being involved from the start over a mile on the main track last month and tries grass for the first time. Dark bay's pedigree suggests that he should take to the surface and trainer Dorochenko wins with 12% going from dirt to turf. Colt can be near the front early with Perez in the irons.

#8 CHANGI (E) (Stalker) Was not a factor when unplaced over six furlongs on the main track in his latest here last month in his first start after a short break. Son of Giant Oak failed to hit the board in one previous start on turf and Hinsley did not win with last thirty-four runners second off a layoff.

#3 CAMPIONI (E) (Closer) Comes off a well-beaten fourth place finish over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track last month in his first start since early-December. Trainer Miller wins with 11% of runners second off a layoff but son of Medaglia d'Oro managed just one third place finish in six previous tries on turf.

#11 AMERICAN HERITAGE (E) (Speed) Tries grass for the first time off a fading unplaced effort after pressing the early pace over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track here last month. Trainer Pompell failed to win with last seven runners first time on turf but gelding has early speed and can be a pace factor with Santiago remaining aboard.

RACE 8

#4 OFF NOTE (E) (Speed) Made it two easy gate-to-wire wins this meet when leading from the start to win her latest on the main track at this level and distance last month. Daughter of First Samurai has hit the board in one of five starts on turf and trainer Rivelli wins with 31% of runners that won last time out and who has won with 44% of starters this meet. Five-year-old figures to be sent early and especially dangerous if this event is moved to the main track.

#8 PUT POSITION (E) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace to win her latest over a mile and a sixteenth on the main track last month in her second start of the year. Dark bay makes her first start on turf and should take to the surface being out of a mare by 14% grass sire Put It Back and trainer Becker wins with 36% of runners third off a layoff and with 32% that won last time out. Filly can be running from just off the pace with Emigh riding.

#10 LORAN HOLIDAY (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced at this distance at Churchill in a tough claiming event last month and has won two of nine starts on turf. Trainer Hiles has won with one of his first fourteen runners this year and daughter of 12% grass sire Harlan's Holiday can be running late with Kennedy in the saddle.

#2 NORTHERN ALLIANCE (E) (Stalker) Was claimed by Justin Johns when giving way badly over a mile and a sixteenth here last month in her first start after a short break. Daughter of Northern Afleet has won three of five starts on this turf and Johns wins with 16% first off the claim. Mare can be running from just off the pace with Lopez riding.

#5 CHLOBEE (E) (Closer) Comes off a distant third place finish at this distance on the main track last month in her first start since October. Daughter of Kitalpha has won two of six starts on this turf and trainer Spagnola won with two of last nine runners second off a layoff. Chestnut can be running late with Meza retaining the mount.

#7 ON MY TOES (U) (Closer) Has a record of 15-2-3-1 lifetime on grass and rallied from off the pace to defeat easier at this distance on the main track here last month. Trainer Cowan wins with just 3% of his runners on turf but with 11% that won last time out and mare can be closing with Felix retaining the mount.

#9 WILDWOOD SCAT (E) (Closer) Was never a threat when unplaced over five and a half furlongs on the main track last month in her second start of the year. Trainer Aguilar wins with 18% of runners third off a layoff and mare has a record of 10-3-1-3 here and can be a factor with Doyle up.

#1 ODACHI (U) (Presser) Was prominent from the start when third over six furlongs on the main track here last month. Daughter of First Samurai has hit the board without winning in nine of fifteen starts on turf and can be a pace factor with Cotto in the irons.

#6 TINDERELLA (U) (Speed) Faded to finish fourth after pressing the early leader in her latest over six furlongs on the main track last month in her first start since September. Trainer Bahena has won with just 3% of runners this year but six-year-old won one of seven previous starts on this turf and can be near the front early with Ulloa riding.

#3 BAHAMA KITTEN (U) (Closer) Makes her first start for trainer Winebaugh and has not been seen since showing little at this distance at Gulfstream in February in her first outing after a long break. Five-year-old has won three of fifteen starts on turf but Winebaugh failed with last fifteen that had not raced for 90 days or more and daughter of Kitten's Joy may be best watched this time.
