Race 1

#2 SUPERSTAR DIVA (D) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace when winning her latest over the track and distance last month. Daughter of Data Link has a record of 13-3-3-4 on this oval and trainer Candelas wins with 9% of her runners in claiming events. Dark bay can be running from off the pace with Perez retaining the mount.

#4 TINDERELLA (E) (Speed) Faded to finish unplaced after chasing the early pace over one mile at this level this month. Daughter of Borrego has won four of 14 starts at this distance and trainer Bahena has won with 22% of runners at this meet. Bay figures to be the one to catch under Baird, who has won with two of his last eight rides for the barn.

#3 KENAI COOL (D) (Closed to win her latest over 5 ½ furlongs last month in her second start since being claimed by Mike Reavis. Mare has won three of 16 starts on this track and Reavis wins with 26% of his runners that won last time out. Daughter of Shanghai Bobby can be closing under Roman, who has won with 27% of his rides for the barn in the past two months.

#1 FIRST SQUADRON (D) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced in an allowance event over one mile and 70 yards in her latest at Indiana last month and tries an all-weather track for the first time. Trainer Cook wins with 7% of his runners in claiming events and dark bay can be stalking the early pace with Gallardo in the irons.

#5 MOUNTAIN MELODIES (D) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced over one mile and 70 yards at Belterra in her latest last month in her second start since being claimed by Karyn Wittek and second after a short break. Filly has hit the board in three of her six previous starts on an all-weather track and can be trying to close with Bowen riding.

Race 2

#4 VARSITY FLYGIRL (D) (Stalker) Drops in class off a fading fifth-place finish over 6 furlongs in her latest early this month in her third start after a short break. Daughter of Summer Front has won one of her six career starts and trainer Gulick wins with 20% of his runners going from a sprint to a route and with 19% of starters in claiming events. 3-year-old can be forwardly placed early and tough at this level with Carroll retaining the mount.

#3 OXBOW'S RUBY (D) (Stalker) Comes off a well-beaten fourth-place finish over one mile and 70 yards at Belterra three weeks ago in her second start after a short break. Trainer Wittek won with three of her last 11 runners third time off a layoff and has won with two of her eight runners at this meet. Daughter of Oxbow can be a factor under Bowen, who has won with one of his last three rides for the barn.

#1 SPECIAL CONQUEST (U) (Closer) Weakened late when second over one mile and 70 yards in her latest at Belterra last month in her first start since April. Dark bay has won just one of her 45 career starts but hit the board in one of five outings on this oval and can be a contender for a small share with Gallardo riding.

#2 GODSGIFT (E) (Stalker) Comes off a fourth-place finish after chasing the early pace over 5 furlongs on turf at this level this month in her third start of the year. Trainer Zawitz has won with four of his 11 starters at this meet but gray failed to hit the board in four previous starts on this Polytrack.

#5 THE MORE I BURN (U) (Stalker) Comes off a well-beaten third-place finish at this distance at Fairmount earlier this month and failed to hit the board in two previous starts on an all-weather track. Barn has won with just one of 51 runners this year and 4-year-old can be a brief pace factor with Roman aboard.

Race 3

#2 TALE OF THE NILE (E) (Stalker) Closed some from just off the pace when second as the favorite over 7 furlongs at this level in his latest this month. Son of Pioneer of the Nile has a lifetime record of 37-8-7-4 on all-weather tracks and trainer Vanden Berg wins with 29% of her runners that were beaten as the favorite last time out and with 41% of his starters in claiming events. Gelding can be in good position from the start with Emigh remaining aboard.

#6 DRIVER DAN (D) (Speed) Was caught late after leading from the start when second over the track and distance in his latest this month. Trainer Hughes has won with 10% of his runners this year and son of Uncle Mo has hit the board in three of six starts on this oval. Bay figures to be sent early again with apprentice Lopez retaining the mount.

#4 FORT RIDGE (E) (Closer) Comes off a well-beaten fourth-place finish over 7 furlongs at this level in his latest early this month. Gray has a record of 11-3-1-0 on this oval and trainer Mason wins with 14% of her claimers. Son of Fort Prado can be closing late with Gallardo riding.

#5 KEARNY COUNTY (D) (Closer) Was not a factor when a well-beaten fourth over the track and distance in a starter allowance event in his latest a week ago. Trainer Meraz wins with 12% of his claimers and son of Stroll has a record of 6-1-2-1 on all-weather tracks and can be a contender for a share with Roman up.

#1 CALL THE COLONEL (E) (Closer) Did not threaten when unplaced over the track and distance at this level in his latest early this month. Son of Colonel John has managed just two third-place finishes from eight starts on this oval and needs improvement on recent efforts to be a factor.

#3 ALLEGIANCE (D) (Stalker) Has not raced since finishing sixth in an even effort over one mile on grass here last August. Dark bay has some tactical speed but failed to hit the board in three previous starts on this oval and may need this outing.

Race 4

#6 JUJU'S SPECIALGIRL (E) (Stalker) Finished third as the favorite at this distance on the Polytrack at this level in her latest last month in her third start of the year. Chestnut has a record of 13-2-3-2 on turf and trainer Rivelli wins with 25% of his runners on grass and with 33% of his claimers. Daughter of Winslow Homer can be along from off the pace with Loveberry retaining the mount.

#5 WOKE UP TO ACES (D) (Presser) Comes off a sixth-place finish in an even effort as the favorite last month facing better in her first start since being claimed by Eddie Kenneally. Daughter of The Factor has

won one of her seven starts on turf and Kenneally wins with 29% of his runners second time off the claim. Filly can be a contender with Carroll in the saddle.

#3 U. S. CURRENCY (U) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace when defeating easier in her latest over 5 furlongs here last month. Daughter of Exchange Rate has a record of 13-3-5-3 on turf and trainer Perez has won with 12% of his runners since the beginning of this year. Gray can be in good position from the start under Hernandez, who has won with two of his last seven rides for the barn.

#2 APOLLO U ANYWHERE (U) (Speed) Second from the Perez barn weakened to finish a well-beaten third after leading early over one mile facing softer in her latest this month in her third start of the year. Perez wins with 13% of his runners going from a route to a sprint and daughter of Prospective ha won one of her six starts on turf. Bay can be on or near the early lead with Santiago in the irons.

#1 RANK AND FILE (U) (Stalker) Closed some from off the pace when third over 5 furlongs facing easier in her latest this month in her second start since being claimed by Elias Lopez. Mare has won one of her four starts on this turf and Lopez has won with two six runners at this meet. Daughter of Data Link can be trying to close late with Tavares retaining the mount.

#7 LADY ATLANTIC (U) (Stalker) Main Track Only entrant drew off to defeat easier by nine lengths in her latest over 6 furlongs on the Polytrack early this month. Trainer Ryan wins with 13% of runners that won last time but daughter of Stormy Atlantic will likely struggle at this level if this event is moved off the turf.

#4 GO STORMIN GIRL (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced over 5 furlongs at this level in her latest last month in her first start since September. Trainer Sanner wins with 17% of his claimers but filly may be best watched again here.

Race 5
