Race 1

#3 RULE FOLLOWER (D) (Speed) Drops into a maiden claiming event for the first time off a well-beaten second-place finish after pressing the early pace over the track and distance in September in his third outing. Trainer Rivelli wins with 35% of his runners that have not raced for 90+ days and with 26% of his starters making this class drop. Son of Algorithms cost \$275K as a yearling and can be on or near the early lead with Loveberry riding.

#6 BASEBALL POLITICS (D) (Presser) Second from the Rivelli barn weakened to finish third over 5 ½ furlongs facing better in his latest this month and has hit the board in both of his two career starts. Rivelli wins with 28% of his maiden claimers and son of Midnight Lute is a half-brother to one winner. Dark bay can be in the early mix under Baird, but does lose previous rider Loveberry to barn's other entrant.

#5 GOVERNORS WRAITH (1st Starter) Newcomer by 9% first-out sire Governor Charlie is a half-brother to one winner and trainer Puhich wins with 15% of his first-time starters. Dark bay has been working forwardly and Puhich wins with 15% of his maiden claimers. Dark bay could be ready for a decent first outing with Bowen riding.

#2 QUALITY HOUR (D) (Stalker) Gets blinkers added and drops in class for his first try on an all-weather surface off a weakening sixth-place finish over 5 furlongs on grass at Indiana last month in his first start since his debut in April. Trainer Deegan won with three of his last nine runners second off a layoff and son of Elusive Quality can be a contender for a share with Carroll in the saddle.

#1 RETAIN (1st Starter) Trainer Silva won with three of his last eight first-time starters and saddles debuting son of 11% first-out sire Uncaptured, who is a half-brother to two winners. 4-year-old has been working forwardly but rail post is not ideal for a newcomer and barn looks for first winner of the meet.

#4 OUTRIDER (D) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced after chasing the early pace over one mile on grass facing better in his latest in early-June in his fourth career start. Trainer Boyce wins with 16% of her maiden claimers and son of Istan can be running late under Felix, who has won with one of his last four rides for the barn.

Race 2

#3 ONE WAY HOME (U) (Presser) Led from the start when easily defeating softer over 1 1/16 miles on the main track three weeks ago in his first start since being claimed by Mike Reavis. Son of Brilliant Speed has a record of 6-1-2-1 on this turf and Reavis wins with 39% of his claimers and has won with 24% of his starters at this meet. Gelding can be in good position from the start under Roman, who has won with 27% of his rides for the barn in the past two months.

#4 ANGELINO (D) (Closer) Faded to finish a well-beaten last of five over 1 1/16 miles in a starter allowance on the Polytrack in his latest this month. Trainer Rivelli wins with 18% of his runners making this surface change and son of Americain has won one of his five starts on this turf course. 6-year-old can be running from off the paced with Loveberry riding.

#6 PLEASANT MOON (E) (Stalker) Weakened to finish a well-beaten third over 1 1/16 miles on the main track at this level in his latest this month in his first start since May and second outing of the year. Gelding failed to hit the board in two previous starts on grass but trainer Bahena wins with 15% of his claimers and has won with 22% of his runners at this meet. Bay can be forwardly placed early under Baird, who has won with two of his last eight rides for the barn.

#2 HANNITY (E) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace when winning his latest on the main track earlier this month. Bay has won one of his seven starts on this turf and can be running late but barn wins with just 4% of claimers that won last time out.

#1 R H SMOAKEM (U) (Closer) Comes off a win from off the pace over 6 furlongs defeating easier at Fairmount last month in his first start since April. Trainer Mason wins with 25% of her claimers that won last time out but son of Mineshaft failed to win in eight previous starts on turf.

#5 HIGH ON SUGAR (D) (Closer) Trailed the field from the start in his latest over the course and distance two weeks ago. Gelding has won three of his 18 starts on this turf but needs a form reversal off efforts this year to be a threat.

Race 3

#4 RIVER EVANGELIST (D) (Closer) Drops in class off a never-threatening unplaced effort after a slow start over one mile on turf last month. Son of Tapit hit the board in both of his two previous starts on all-weather tracks and trainer Rodriguez wins with 12% of his maiden claimers. Chestnut can be tough at this level from off the pace under Hernandez, who has won with one of his last seven rides for the barn.

#2 CADET CAPTAIN (E) (Presser) Faded to finish a distant fifth after chasing the early pace over 7 furlongs at this level in his latest early this month. Gelding has a record of 15-5-3-1 at this distance and trainer Cowan has won with 11% of his runners this year. Chestnut can be on or near the early lead with Baird taking the mount.

#6 JOEY B (E) (Stalker) Made late progress when second over one mile and 70 yards at this level in his latest at Fairmount this month. Dark bay has hit the board in two of his four previous starts on this oval and trainer Higgins won with one of his last five runners in claiming events. Son of Freud can be running late with Tavares riding.

#1 SPLASH FOR GOLD (E) (Stalker) Gave way to finish a well-beaten last of five over one mile at Fairmount in his latest last month. Trainer Mason wins with 14% of her claimers and gelding can be stalking the early pace but failed to hit the board in two previous starts on this main track.

#5 TIMINGISEVERYTHING (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced over the track and distance at this level in his latest last month. 8-year-old has won one of his 14 starts on this oval but three most recent efforts at this meet do not inspire confidence.

#3 SATURDAYS HANGOVER (E) (Closer) Passed a couple of tired rivals when unplaced at this level over 7 furlongs in his latest this month. Gelding has failed to win in 28 starts on this oval and appears unlikely to reverse that trend here.

Race 4

#2 CAPT. MAESTRI (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced over one mile at Churchill in his latest in early-November and tries an all-weather surface for the first time. Son of Tapit has hit the board in one of his two starts and trainer Pessin wins with 9% of his runners that have not raced for 90+ days. 5-year-old can be along from off the pace with Loveberry taking the mount.

#4 CAPTAIN FANTASTIC (E) (Closer) Made belated progress when fifth over one mile on grass here in his latest this month. Son of Midnight Lute finished second in one of his two outings on this Polytrack and trainer Puhich wins with 14% of his runners in maiden special weight events. Dark bay can be a contender from off the pace with Bowen remaining aboard.

#3 DUCKDEVIL (E) (Stalker) Weakened late when second after vying for the early lead in his latest over 1 1/16 miles here early this month in his third start of the year. Trainer Beasley has won with 13% of his runners this year and son of Daredevil has hit the board in all three of his starts on this main track. Chestnut can be near the front early with Wiseman again in the saddle.

#1 COMMODORE PERRY (E) (Closer) Flattened out when fifth after making some progress from off the pace over 1 1/16 miles on turf at Indiana in his latest last month in his second start after a short break. Gelding hit the board in one of his two previous starts on an all-weather surface and trainer Colebrook has won with 10% of his runners this year. 3-year-old can be closing late with Emigh up.

#6 SPECIAL PRYCE (U) (Presser) Was prominent from the start when second facing easier over 6 ½ furlongs in his latest in early-June. Trainer Swearingen wins with 9% of his runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and bay can be a pace factor with Camacho in the irons.

#5 DREAM KEEPER (E) (Speed) Tries an all-weather surface for the first time off a fading unplaced effort over one mile on grass here earlier this month in his first start since February. Gelding has hit the board in two of his five career starts and may be sent early under Felix, who has won with one of his last four rides for the barn.

Race 5

#6 AGAVE KID (E) (Speed) Weakened when third after leading early over one mile at this level in his latest this month. Gelding has a record of 4-1-0-1 on this Polytrack and trainer Manley wins with 18% of his claimers and has won with 18% of his starters at this meet. Bay is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and figures to be the one to catch under Baird, who has won with three of his last five rides for the barn.

#5 TOM'S LAST GENERAL (E) (Stalker) Was prominent from the start when second over one mile at this level in his latest earlier this month in his first start on this oval. Trainer Jones wins with just 4% of runners in claiming events and dark bay has won just one of 28 career starts but can be forwardly placed from the start with apprentice Lopez remaining aboard.

#4 LADY CREED (D) (Closer) Weakened to finish a well-beaten fifth on a sloppy surface at Belterra facing better early this month. Daughter of Jimmy Creed has won one of her two previous starts on this oval and trainer Wittek wins with 15% of her runners making this surface change. Mare can be running from off the pace with Bowen riding.

#1 EGOMANIAC (D) (Closer) Drops in class off a never-threatening unplaced effort at this distance in grass last month. Gelding finished second at this level and distance on this track two back and trainer

Mason wins with 28% of her runners making this surface change. Son of Cyber Secret has not won in a while but can be a contender for a share with Wiseman retaining the mount.

#7 POWERFUL MAN (U) (Stalker) Drew off to easily break his maiden by 15 lengths in his latest earlier this month. Trainer Dorochenko failed to win with last 11 runners that broke their maiden last time out but bay showed much improved form in his latest and is worth a look with Tavares remaining aboard.

#2 DARK WOOD (E) (Stalker) Faded to finished a well-beaten fourth at this level over one mile in his latest last month. Gelding has some tactical speed but has won just one of his 35 career starts and barn wins with just 4% of runners on all-weather tracks.

#3 MANGO TREE (E) (Stalker) Comes off a fading unplaced effort on grass over one mile at this level this month. Chestnut failed to hit the board in one previous start on this Polytrack and seems unlikely to find needed improvement to be a threat.

Race 6

#5 WELLABLED (D) (Speed) Is unbeaten in three previous starts on this Polytrack and was caught late after leading from the start when a close third in his latest over 5 furlongs in a stakes on grass at Canterbury in his latest last month. Trainer Rivelli wins with 27% of his runners making this surface change and has won with 37% of his starters at this meet. 7-year-old figures to be the one to catch with Loveberry in the saddle.

#7 I'M CORFU (E) (Presser) Narrowly missed when second in a raced declared a no contest in in his latest at Churchill early last month in his first outing since April. Dark bay has a record of 17-3-3-0 on all-weather tracks and trainer Vanden Berg has won with 35% of runners at this meet. Gelding can be forwardly placed early with Emigh in the irons.

#1 WHAT'S UP DUDE (D) (Closer) Was game when a close third over one mile in his latest in the Hanshin here last month. Gray has won seven of his 21 starts on this oval and trainer Cristel wins with 10% of his runners going from a route to a sprint. Son of First Dude can be running late with Baird riding.

#3 HIDE THE DEMON (U) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace to defeat easier over the track and distance in his latest last month. Trainer Campbell wins with 15% of his runners in allowance events and son of Run Away and Hide has a record of 6-3-1-0 here. Bay can be a contender for a share with Felix retaining the mount.

#6 DEVILEYE (U) (Closer) Made progress when third over 7 furlongs in his latest facing easier here early last month. Gelding has won five of his eight starts on this oval and trainer Boyce has won with 33% of her runners at this meet. Bay can be trying to close with Roman in the saddle.

#4 WILE E PEYOTE (U) (Closer) Was claimed by Brian Cook when second in an even effort over the track and distance last month in his second start after a short break. Cook has won with 7% of his runners this year and gelding has won three of 11 starts on this oval but has not won in a while and takes on better here.

#2 NUCLEAR OPTION (U) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced at this distance in his latest at Oaklawn in early-May. Trainer Mason wins with 15% of her runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and gelding has won one of his nine starts on this oval but is likely just a brief pace factor with Wiseman up.

Race 7

#8 WILL KNOWS (D) (Stalker) Main Track Only entrant has a record of 3-1-1-1 on all-weather tracks and comes off a well-beaten last of five place-finish at Indiana in early June in his second start since being claimed by Brittany Vanden Berg. Gelding has won nine of his 29 career starts and Vanden Berg has won with 35% of her runners at this meet. Dark bay can be forwardly placed early and likely the one to beat if this event is moved off the turf.

#9 STORMINSIDE (U) (Speed) Stablemate of the top selection is also entered for the Main Track Only and was claimed by Vanden Berg when leading from the start to defeat easier over 6 furlongs on the Polytrack in his latest this month. Vanden Berg wins with 41% of her runners first time off the claim and gray has a record of 11-4-3-0 on all-weather tracks. 7-year-old is likely the one to catch if this event is moved to the main track.

#5 MONGOL BULL (U) (Presser) Led from the start when winning his latest over the course and distance last month in his second start after a short break. Gelding has a record of 15-7-4-1 on this turf and trainer Rainwater wins with 32% of runners that won last time out. Son of Hard Spun can be in the early mix with Perez retaining the mount.

#6 SHANGHAI POINT (D) (Presser) Hit the board in two of his six previous starts on grass and drops in class off a fading fifth-place finish over 6 furlongs at Fairmount last month. Trainer Plasters won with one of her last three runners making this surface change and has won with one of her six starters at this meet. Dark bay can be forwardly placed early with Emigh in the irons.

#2 BOOM BOX (U) (Closer) Was prominent from the start when second over the course and distance in his latest this month in his third start of the year. Trainer Reid has won with one of his eight runners at this meet and gelding has a record of 27-6-5-7 on this turf. Chestnut can be running late with Uske again in the saddle. sp

#7 RIPE ATTACK (U) (Stalker) Made progress when third over the course and distance in his latest this month. Gelding has won seven of his 51 career starts and trainer Swearingen wins with 10% of his claimers. Dark bay can be stalking the early pace with Roman remaining aboard.

#4 HERE COMES KYLE (D) Faded to finish unplaced over 6 furlongs at Fairmount in his latest in June. Son of Smoke Warning has not won in a while but has a record of 11-1-1-1 on this turf and will be taking on easier than he has faced in some time.

#3 POWER CRY (U) (Presser) Finished fourth after chasing the early pace in his latest over the course and distance last month. Son of Distorted Humor has failed to hit the board in six starts on grass but can be a pace factor with Gallardo up.

#1 SEANSHINE (U) (Presser) Faded to finish unplaced after showing some early speed over the course and distance in his latest this month. Trainer Perez wins with 11% of his claimers and gelding may flash early speed breaking from the rail with apprentice Lopez riding.

Race 8

#3 SIMPLE LOGIC (E) (Stalker) Made some progress when second over 5 ½ furlongs here this month and has hit the board in both of two starts on this oval. Son of Maclean's Music is a half-brother to one

winner and trainer Rainwater has won three of seven runners at this meet. Bay is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be in good position from the start with Perez retaining the mount.

#6 PERFECT DIVA (U) (Presser) Was claimed by Eduardo Rodriguez when flattening out to finish second at this distance on turf here in her latest early this month. Filly facing males finished third in one previous start on this main track and Rodriguez wins with 17% of his runners first time off the claim. Daughter of Perfect Soul can be near the front from the start under Baird, who has won with two of his last five rides for the barn.

#1 GOOD YEGG (E) (Stalker) Weakened to finish fourth over 5 ½ furlongs in his latest two weeks ago in his second start for trainer Slager and second outing of the year. Slager has won with 10% of his runners at this meet and son of Big Bad Mike can be in the early mix with Tavares riding.

#5 POLITO (U) (Closer) Makes his first start for trainer Silva off a well-beaten third-place finish over 7 ½ furlongs facing easier on grass at Canterbury last month in his first start since December and tries an all-weather surface for the first time. Silva looks for first winner of the year but son of Three Hour Nap can be a contender for a share with Emigh in the irons.

#4 DREAM ATTACK (E) (Closer) Was not a threat when unplaced over 6 furlongs in his latest last month in his third outing. Son of Forest Attack has been unplaced in all three career starts and seems unlikely to find needed improvement to be a serious threat.

#2 ROCKET RIDE (U) (Closer) Finished a distant second over 1 1/16 miles facing easier in his latest last month. Gelding is still a maiden after 28 starts and takes on better here for trainer Perez, who is having a slow meet.

#7 KINGSBURRY ATTACK (E) (Closer) Has been well-beaten in all four outings, most recently when last of six over 6 furlongs here last month. Trainer Childers has won with 8% of his runners at this meet but gelding needs to find improvement to be a factor.

#8 LOOK AWAY (U) (Closer) Makes his first outing for trainer Jones off a well-beaten unplaced effort over 1 1/16 miles earlier this month and has shown little in two outings. Jones looks for first winner of the year and son of Tizway will be a longshot.

Best Bets:

Race 5

#6 AGAVE KID (E) (Speed) Weakened when third after leading early over one mile at this level in his latest this month. Gelding has a record of 4-1-0-1 on this Polytrack and trainer Manley wins with 18% of his claimers and has won with 18% of his starters at this meet. Bay is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and figures to be the one to catch under Baird, who has won with three of his last five rides for the barn.

\$5 Exacta 6 with 4,5 = \$10

\$5 Pick Three 6 with 5 with 5,8,9 = \$15

Race 6

#5 WELLABLED (D) (Speed) Is unbeaten in three previous starts on this Polytrack and was caught late after leading from the start when a close third in his latest over 5 furlongs in a stakes on grass at Canterbury in his latest last month. Trainer Rivelli wins with 27% of his runners making this surface change and has won with 37% of his starters at this meet. 7-year-old figures to be the one to catch with Loveberry in the saddle.
