Race 1

#5 RACHELGOTSTEPHEN (D) (Closer) Drops in class off a fading unplaced effort over one mile here early last month. Mare has a record of 13-2-0-3 on this oval and trainer Kirby wins with 25% of his runners that have not raced for 46-90 days and with 18% of his claimers. Gray can be tough at this level under Emigh, who has won with 27% of his rides for the barn in the past two months.

#9 MISS SURPRISE (D) (Speed) Tries an all-weather track for the first time and weakened to finish unplaced facing better over 2 furlongs at Thistledown in her latest last month in her first start since April. Trainer Sullivan wins with 16% of his runners second time off a layoff and daughter of Midshipman has won five of 38 career outings. 6-year-old figures to be the one to catch with Camacho in the irons.

#10 DRAMA RUN (D) (Stalker) Comes off a well-beaten fourth-place finish over the track and distance last month in her second start since being claimed by Mike Reavis and second after a short break. Reavis wins with 25% of his claimers and has won with 20% of his runners at this meet. Mare has won two of 10 starts here and can be in good early position with Baird riding.

#7 WILDWOOD MAGGIE (D) (Closer) Was last seen when a well-beaten fifth over one mile facing slightly better here in July. Trainer Campbell won with one of his last four runners that had not raced for 46-90 days and daughter of Kantharos has a record of 5-1-1-1 here. Chestnut can be trying to close late with Roman remaining aboard.

#8 CONSTANCIA (D) (Stalker) Made progress when third over the track and distance in her latest last month in her third start of the year. Daughter of Street Boss has won two of 11 starts on this Polytrack and trainer Aguayo wins with 8% of his claimers. Mare has some tactical speed and can be forwardly placed early with Severino up.

#4 NICE AND TRUE (D) (Presser) Makes her first start for trainer Candelas off a weakening fourth-place finish after vying for the early lead over 5 furlongs on grass six days ago. Daughter of Square Eddie has a record of 10-2-2-1 on all-weather tracks and Candelas wins with 10% of runners in claiming events. Dark bay can be in the early mix with Lopez in the irons.

#6 REJOICE AN BE GLAD (U) (Closer) Rallied from just off the pace when defeating easier at Fairmount over one mile and 70 yards in her latest last month. Chestnut has hit the board in two of four previous starts on this oval and trainer Thurman has won with one of eight runners at this meet. 7-year-old can be closing with Diego retaining the mount.

#2 GODSGIFT (D) (Stalker) Closed some when sixth over 5 furlongs on grass in her latest early this month and has won one of six starts on this main track. Trainer Zawitz has won with 21% of his runners at this meet and gray can be stalking the early pace with Tavares again in the saddle.

#1 LADY EXPRESS (U) (Closer) Was not a factor when last of six runners over 6 furlongs at Fairmount facing easier last month. Daughter of Notional has won three of her nine previous starts on this oval but needs some improvement on recent efforts to be a contender.

#3 SINGING ALLI (U) (Closer) Makes her first start for trainer DiZeo and comes off a well-beaten last of six at Prairie Meadows early this month. Chestnut has not won in a while and may be best watched in her first start on an all-weather surface.

Race 2

#4 RAPID TRANSIT (D) (Closer) Closed some when fourth in an allowance at this distance at Ellis in her latest early this month. Daughter of Bullet Train has a lifetime record of 12-5-1-2 on turf and trainer Poulos wins with 12% of her runners on grass and with 12% in claiming events. Mare won over the course and distance at this level two back and can be running late with Santiago in the irons.

#5 SMACK (E) (Presser) Narrowly missed when second after being involved from the start over the course and distance at this level in her latest last month in her first start since being claimed by Mike Reavis. Daughter of Super Saver has a record of 4-2-1-1 on this turf and Reavis wins with 17% of his runners second time off the claim. Mare can be near the front from the start under Roman, who has won with 18% of his rides for the barn in the past 60 days.

#6 WINDY CITY GIRL (E) (Closer) Finished well when a close third over the course and distance at this level in her first start since being claimed by Larry Rivelli. Mare has won one of her nine starts here and Rivelli wins with 31% second off the claim and has won with 36% of his starters at this meet. Daughter of Gio Ponti can be closing with Baird remaining aboard.

#2 NORTHERN ALLIANCE (E) (Stalker) Weakened when fifth after leading early over the course and distance at this level in her latest last month. Trainer Rodriguez has won with 18% of his runners at this meet and daughter of Northern Afleet has a record of 15-5-2-0 on this turf. Mare can be near the front early with Perez retaining the mount.

#3 APRIL'S GEM (D) (Stalker) Made belated progress while unplaced facing better over the course and distance in her latest this month. Trainer Reid wins with 9% of his claimers and daughter of Gemologist has won two of eight starts on this turf. Gray can be trying to close from just off the pace with Uske in the irons.

#1 GLITTERARY (U) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace when defeating easier over the course and distance in her latest last month in her second start after a short break. Filly has won both of her two starts on this turf and trainer Robertson wins with 33% of his runners third time off a layoff and with 25% that won last time out. Daughter of Declaration of War can be running late with Camacho again in the saddle.

#9 ZANDREA'S (E) (Stalker) Was claimed by Eduardo Rodriguez when fourth in an even effort at this level over the course and distance in her latest last month. Rodriguez wins with 16% of his runners first time off the claim and filly has hit the board in three of four starts on this turf. Chestnut can be forwardly placed early with Tavares riding.

#8 WHITE LIES (D) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced in a stakes in her latest over 6 furlongs on the main track in her latest last month. Trainer Miller has won with 17% of her runners at this meet but filly failed to hit the board in four previous starts on grass and was well-beaten at this level over the course and distance two back.

#7 CITY FUN (E) (Closer) Was last seen when a non-threatening fifth over the course and distance at this level in early-August. Dark bay has won two of seven starts on grass but needs improvement on her latest and trainer Wainwright wins with just 4% of runners that have not raced for 46-90 days.

Race 3

#6 P H FACTOR (U) (Speed) Weakened late when fourth after leading early at this distance in his latest as the favorite on turf here last month. Trainer Rivelli wins with 34% of his runners that were beaten as the favorite last time out and son of The Factor has won three of his seven starts on this Polytrack. Gray figures to be tough to catch with Baird retaining the mount.

#8 JEFF THE LION (U) (Stalker) Drew off to easily defeat softer by nearly eight lengths in his latest at this distance in his latest two weeks ago. Trainer Boyce wins with 21% of her runners that won last time out and has won with 33% of her starters at this meet. Son of American Lion can be near the front early under Roman, who has won with 33% of his rides for the barn in the past two months.

#7 CAN'T HIDE FROM ME (U) (Closer) Was claimed by Mike Reavis when rallying from off the pace to defeat easier over the track and distance in his latest early this month. Reavis wins with 29% of his runners first time off the claim and son of Awesome Patriot has a record of 12-3-4-1 on this oval. Gelding can be running late with Lopez in the irons.

#9 GO FOR SHERRIE (U) (Stalker) Comes off a second-place finish in an even effort over one mile at Fairmount when claimed by Steve Manley late last month. Manley wins with 12% of his runners first time off the claim and dark bay has won one of his four career starts on all-weather tracks. Son of Flat out can be forwardly placed from the start under Tavares, who has won with two of his last nine rides for the barn.

#4 SLIABH AUGHTY (D) (Stalker) Gave way to finish unplaced over 1 5/16 miles at Kentucky Downs in his latest two weeks ago but has a record of 2-1-1-0 on this Polytrack. Trainer Murphy has won with three of his seven runners at this meet and dark bay can be stalking the early pace with Bowen in the saddle.

#3 TWO WORLDS (D) (Closer) Made some belated progress when fifth in a small stakes at this distance at Fairmount in his latest last month in his third start since being claimed by John Wainwright and second after a short break. Wainwright wins with 22% of his runners third time off a layoff and has won with 13% at this meet. Son of Tapiture can be trying to close but did fail to hit the board in two previous starts on this oval.

#1 POLICY OPTION (U) (Closer) Closed some when second facing easier over one mile on grass in his latest six days ago in his first start since being claimed by Hugo Rodriguez. Son of Empire Maker finished third in one previous start on this main track but takes on better here.

#2 HIGH SPIRITS (U) (Closer) Comes off a well-beaten third-place finish over the track and distance facing easier earlier this month. Trainer Poulos has won with 16% of her runners this year but son of Ghostzapper needs some improvement to be a serious threat.

#5 BULLDOG OF BERGEN (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced at this level and distance on grass in his latest this month. Trainer Aguilar has won with 17% of his starters at this meet but gelding has won just three of 26 starts here and has not won in a long time.

Race 4

#2 CITY DRIFTER (E) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace when winning his latest over 5 furlongs at this level last month. Trainer Davis wins with 14% of his runners that won last time out and son of Temple City has won two of his three career starts on grass. Dark bay is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be in good position from the start with Lopez remaining aboard.

#1 ETCHED IN STONE (E) (Stalker) Comes off a third-place finish in an even effort over 5 furlongs at this level last month. Son of Cairo Prince has a record of 4-1-2-1 on turf and trainer Rivelli has won with 36% of his runners at this meet. Gray can be a factor from just off the pace with Emigh retaining the mount.

#7 VALIANT VINNY (U) (Speed) Second from the Rivelli barn was not a factor after hopping at the start facing easier as the favorite over 5 furlongs last month. Rivelli wins with 34% of his runners that were beaten as the favorite last time out and gelding has hit the board in one of two starts on grass. Bay figures to be sent early with Baird again in the saddle.

#3 RICHY (U) (Stalker) Weakened late when third after vying for the lead from the start over 5 furlongs in his latest here last month. Gelding has won one of his five career starts and trainer Gulick has won with 21% of his runners at this meet. Son of Suntracer can be forwardly placed early with Uske in the irons.

#4 DREAM KEEPER (U) (Presser) Was involved from the start when breaking his maiden over 5 furlongs in his latest earlier this month in his third start after a short break. Trainer Boyce wins with 14% of her runners on grass and son of Super Saver can be forwardly placed early with Felix riding.

#5 POWER THROUGH (U) (Stalker) Comes off a maiden breaking win after being involved throughout last month in his fourth try on grass. Trainer Block wins with 18% of his runners that broke their maiden last time out but gelding finds a tough spot for his first start facing winners.

#6 UPBEAT MELODY (U) (Speed) Was claimed by Alexis Claire when leading from the start to defeat easier over 5 furlongs in his latest six days ago. Claire won with three of last four runners first time off the claim and son of Upstart can be near the front early but takes on much better here.

Race 5

#3 CLEAR N CONVINCING (D) (Closer) Was reclaimed by Larry Rivelli when fifth in and even effort in his latest over 1 1/16 miles last month in his second start of the year. Rivelli wins with 35% of his runners first time off the claim and son of Giant's Causeway has a record of 9-4-1-0 on this turf. Dark bay can be along from off the pace under Baird, who has won with 37% of his rides for the barn in the past 60 days.

#7 SMOKIN RICHIE (E) (Speed) Stablemate of the top selection weakened when fifth after leading early over 5 furlongs in his latest at this level early this month in his first start after a short break. Rivelli wins with 33% of his claimers and son of Awesome of Course has won one of his two starts on grass. Bay figures to be sent early under Emigh, but loses previous rider Baird to the barn's other runner.

#6 GRANDAL (D) (Presser) Has not raced since fading to finish unplaced when bleeding at this distance facing better at Keeneland last October. Gelding won both of his two previous starts on this turf and has been working well for trainer Davis, who wins with 18% of his runners that have not raced for 90+ days. Son of Super Saver can be in the early mix with Bowen riding.

#8 TUFF ATTACK (E) (Closer) Narrowly missed when closing to finish second over 5 furlongs at this level in his latest early this month. Chestnut has a record of 8-2-1-1 on this turf and trainer Childers wins with 11% of his runners on grass. Gelding can be running late into contention with Tavares in the saddle.

#5 BIARRITZ (E) (Stalker) Was prominent from the start when a close third over 5 furlongs at this level in his latest this month in his third start after a near four month break. Son of Flatter has won two of his seven starts on grass and trainer Tracy has won with 10% of his runners this year. Bay can be near the front early with Roman remaining aboard.

#1 THE GREEN MO'STER (E) (Stalker) Closed some when fourth over 5 furlongs in his latest at this level earlier this month. Gelding has won one of his six starts on this turf and trainer Rodriguez wins with 12% of his runners in claiming events. Son of Uncle Mo can be stalking the early pace with Felix in the irons.

#9 TAKE ME UP BRADY (E) (Presser) Makes his first start for trainer DiZeo off a weakening sixth-place finish after dueling for the early lead over 5 furlongs at Canterbury three weeks ago. DiZeo won with two of his last 14 runners first time for his barn and dark bay can be a pace factor with Doyle riding.

#10 MASTER GUNS (U) (Closer) Rallied from just off the pace when defeating easier over 5 furlongs at Canterbury early this month in his second start after a short break. Trainer Robertson wins with 28% of his claimers that won last time out but gelding takes on better here.

#4 BOURBON TAN (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced over one mile at this level in his latest six days ago in his first start since being claimed by Oscar Sanchez. Son of English Channel has won four of his 27 career starts on grass and Sanchez has won with 18% of his starters this year. Bay can be forwardly placed early but needs some improvement to be a serious threat at this level.

#2 KING TITO (D) (Presser) Faded to finish fourth after pressing the early pace over 6 furlongs at Fairmount in his latest last month. Trainer Rodriguez wins with 13% of his runners making this surface change and gelding can be forwardly placed early but was well-beaten in one previous try on turf.

Race 6

#10 AND WON (D) (Closer) Made progress when second from just off the pace in his latest facing better over one mile on grass earlier this month in his second start since being claimed by Manny Perez. Son of Majestic Warrior has hit the board in two of his four starts on this main track and Perez wins with 12% of his claimers. Gelding can be along from off the pace with Bowen retaining the mount.

#2 ANGELINO (D) (Closer) Closed to finish third over one mile on grass in his latest last month. Trainer Rivelli wins with 29% of his runners making this surface change and gelding has a record of 5-2-0-1 on this main track. Dark bay can be running late into contention with Baird remaining aboard.

#11 MEMORY BANK (D) (Closer) Finished well when third over one mile on grass in his latest this month in his second start since being claimed by Doug Matthews. Chestnut has won three of 12 starts on this oval and Matthews wins with 16% of his runners in claiming events. Son of Misremembered can be a contender with Hernandez in the saddle.

#12 HANNITY (D) (Closer) Gave way badly when unplaced over the track and distance facing better in his latest this month in his first start since being claimed by Brittany Vanden Berg. Bay has won one of 11

starts here and Vanden Berg won with nine of last 17 runners second off the claim. Bay should be more competitive at this level with Emigh aboard.

#8 CAPPY HOUR (E) (Presser) Led from the start when winning his latest on turf at Mountaineer over one mile earlier this month and tries an all-weather surface for the first time. Trainer Sullivan has won with 23% of his runners this year and gelding has won four of 19 career starts. Gelding figures to be on or near the early lead with Camacho riding.

#7 JUSTENUFFTUFF (E) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace when winning his latest at Fairmount late last month. Bay has a record of 8-1-1-2 on this oval and trainer Randazzo wins with 18% of his runners that won last time out. 6-year-old can be near the front early under Tavares, who has won with two of his last seven rides for the barn.

#1 HIGH ON SUGAR (E) (Closer) Closed to win his latest at this level over the track and distance earlier this month. Son of Lemon Drop Kid has won two of his 10 starts here and trainer Slager has won with 14% of his runners at this meet. Bay can be running late for a chance at a share with Ortega again in the saddle.

#5 DRIVER DAN (E) (Speed) Weakened late when second after leading from the start over the track and distance at this level this month. Trainer Hughes has won with 8% of his runners at this meet and son of Uncle Mo has hit the board in five of his 10 starts here. Bay can be in the early mix with Lopez riding.

#9 CADET CAPTAIN (E) (Presser) Gave way to finish unplaced after pressing the early leader over the track and distance at this level this month. Trainer Cowan has won with 9% of his runners at this meet and chestnut can be a pace factor with Felix in the irons.

#3 KEARNY COUNTY (D) (Closer) Did not threaten when unplaced over one mile on grass in his latest earlier this month. Son of Stroll has a record of 5-1-1-2 on this main track and can be trying to close with Roman in the saddle.

#4 ANDREW THE GIANT (D) (Closer) Comes off a well-beaten unplaced effort over one mile facing better at Fairmount in his latest last month. Dark bay has failed to win in seven previous starts on this oval and trainer Delong has won with just one of 28 starters at this meet.

#6 BEHIND ENEMY LINES (D) (Closer) Was not a factor when sixth over 6 furlongs in his latest at Fairmount this month in his first start since being reclaimed by Gerald Butler in July. Butler won with three of his last six runners second off the claim but gray has not won in a long time and needs some improvement on recent efforts to be competitive.

Race 7

#13 CHRISTIAN C (U) (Stalker) Was claimed by Mike Reavis when defeating easier from just off the pace over the course and distance in his latest earlier this month. Chestnut has a record of 16-8-4-3 on this turf and Reavis wins with 29% of his runners first time off the claim. Son of Kitalpha is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be forwardly placed early if drawing in off the AE list.

#10 DUCHOSSOIS (U) (Stalker) Made some progress when third over 1 1/16 miles on the main track in his latest here last month. Trainer Vanden Berg wins with 27% of her runners in allowance events and

has won with 31% of her starters at this meet. Chestnut has won three of six starts on this turf and can be stalking the early pace with Emigh remaining aboard.

#11 KINETIC SWAGGER (U) (Presser) Was nailed late when second after leading from the start at this distance in his latest at Canterbury two weeks ago. Son of Proud Citizen has a record of 12-2-3-3 on grass and trainer Robertson has won with 13% of his runners at this meet. Dark bay can be on or near the early lead under Camacho, who has won with five of his last nine rides for the barn.

#3 WAR CHEST (E) (Presser) Led from the start when winning his latest at this level over 1 1/16 miles this month and has a record of 7-1-3-1 on this turf. Trainer Rodriguez wins with 20% of his runners that won last time out and son of War Front can be in the early mix with Perez retaining the mount.

#4 GATE CREW (E) (Closer) Finished well when a close second over 1 1/16 miles at this level in his latest this month. Son of Langfuhr has hit the board in four of six starts on grass and trainer Boyce wins with 16% of her runners in allowance events. Gelding can be running late with Lopez in the irons.

#7 MY BARILEY (E) (Closer) Was reclaimed by Tony Granitz when unplaced over the course and distance in his latest last month. Granitz wins with 32% of his runners first time off the claim and son of Mizzen Mast has won six of his 43 starts on grass. Son of Mizzen Mast can be closing under Bowen, who has won with two of his last six rides for the barn.

#8 RED FLAG ALERT (E) (Stalker) Comes off a third-place finish in an even effort over the course and distance last month in his third start after a short break. Gelding has won one of his seven starts on turf and trainer Winebaugh has won with 14% of her runners at this meet. 4-year-old can be stalking the early leaders with Tavares in the saddle.

#1 CURLINGTON (E) (Closer) Did not threaten when unplaced at this level over 1 1/16 miles in his latest last month in his first start since being claimed by Lori Plasters in July. Gelding has hit the board in two of three starts on this turf and Plasters won with three of last four runners second off the claim. Son of Curlin can be running late with Santiago riding.

#6 NILES CHANNEL (U) (Stalker) Narrowly missed when second from just off the pace over the course and distance facing easier in his latest this month in his first start since being claimed by Dee Poulos and first on grass. Poulos wins with 12% of her runners on turf and gelding can be forwardly placed early but does take on better here.

#9 BARLEEWON (E) (Closer) Made late progress when fifth in his latest over 1 1/16 miles at this level this month in his third start for trainer Rodriguez. Bay has won four of his 19 starts on turf and Rodriguez wins with 9% of his runners in allowance events. Gelding can be trying to close with Felix up.

#12 ADMIRAL RETURNS (E) (Closer) Weakened late to finish fifth over 1 1/16 miles in his latest one week ago. Bay has won one of five career starts and trainer Kirby wins with 11% of his runners in allowance events but colt has won just one outing and faces multiple winners here.

#5 BRIDGEKEEPER (U) (Stalker) Rallied from off the pace when breaking his maiden over the course and distance in his latest in July in his third career start. Trainer Granitz wins with 14% of his runners that broke their maiden last time out but chestnut finds a tough spot for his first start facing winners.

#14 POCKET PLAYER (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced at this level over 6 furlongs at Fairmount in his latest this month. Trainer Wilborn won with two of his six runners at this meet but son of Afleet Alex has won just one of 17 career starts on grass.

#2 STALLONE (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced over 6 furlongs at Fairmount in his latest this month. Bay has some tactical speed but failed to hit the board in one previous start on turf and is likely just a brief pace factor.

Race 8

#4 DEWEY'S HIT (D) (Presser) Weakened when sixth after making a bid for the lead from just off the pace in his latest over the course and distance facing slightly better this month. Trainer Rivelli win with 33% of his claimers and son of Hit It a Bomb has a record of 7-1-2-0 on grass. Dark bay can be on or near the early lead with Lopez retaining the mount.

#9 WILD FOX (D) (Presser) Comes off a weakening third-place finish at this distance facing better at Fairmount last month. Son of Uncaptured failed to hit the board in three previous starts on turf but is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and trainer Becker has won with 20% of his runners at this meet. Bay can be forwardly placed from the start under Santiago, who has won with 53% of his rides for the barn in the past two months.

#8 ROAR OF THE LION (D) (Closer) Narrowly missed when closing to finish second over the course and distance in his latest this month. Trainer Swearingen wins with 10% of his claimers and son of Kitten's Joy has a record of 18-1-1-5 on this turf. Chestnut has not won in a long time but can be a contender for a share from off the pace with Bowen remaining aboard.

#1 ZARMAE (D) (Stalker) Made belated progress when fifth over the course and distance facing better in his latest this month. Chestnut has won one of his five starts on this turf and trainer Wainwright has won with 19% of his runners since the beginning of this year. Son of Tapizar can be a factor with Felix again in the saddle.

#5 SPEAK ENGLISH (D) (Stalker) Weakened when unplaced over the course and distance after pressing the early pace in her latest this month. Dark bay has won two of six starts on this turf and trainer Wittek has won with 17% of starters at this meet. Daughter of English Channel can be forwardly placed early with Bailey in the irons.

#6 GIANT'S FORREST (D) (Closer) Comes off a fading fourth-place finish at this distance on the Polytrack last month. Trainer Jones wins with just 3% of his runners on grass and gelding has not hit the board in four starts on turf.

#2 DARK WOOD (D) (Stalker) Finished second in an even effort at this distance on the main track earlier this month. Gelding has hit the board in just one of his five starts on grass and has won just two of his 39 career outings.

#7 CANIHAVEITLIKETHAT (D) (Closer) Comes off a fading unplaced effort over the course and distance this month in his first start since May. Trainer Rodriguez wins with 10% of his runners second off a layoff and gelding gets some class relief but has not hit the board in five starts on this turf.

#3 DANCIN NICKY (D) (Stalker) Gave way badly when unplaced at this distance on the Polytrack in his latest this month. Bay has some tactical speed but failed to hit the board in seven previous starts on turf.

#2 CITY DRIFTER (E) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace when winning his latest over 5 furlongs at this level last month. Trainer Davis wins with 14% of his runners that won last time out and son of Temple City has won two of his three career starts on grass. Dark bay is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be in good position from the start with Lopez remaining aboard.

#10 AND WON (D) (Closer) Made progress when second from just off the pace in his latest facing better over one mile on grass earlier this month in his second start since being claimed by Manny Perez. Son of Majestic Warrior has hit the board in two of his four starts on this main track and Perez wins with 12% of his claimers. Gelding can be along from off the pace with Bowen retaining the mount.
