Race 1

#7 PINBALLER (1<sup>st</sup> Starter) Trainer Robertson wins with 15% of his first-time starters and saddles debuting son of Cross Traffic, who cost \$55K as a yearling. Gelding has been working forwardly and Robertson win with 21% of his runners overall in maiden claiming events. Bay can win at first asking under Camacho, who has won with five of his last nine rides for the barn.

#6 GOVERNORS WRAITH (1<sup>st</sup> Starter) Newcomer by young sire Governor Charlie is out of a mare by Ghostzapper and debuts for trainer Puhich, who wins with 14% of his first-time starters. Filly facing males has been working well and Puhich has won with 10% of his runners this year. Dark bay can be a threat with Bowen in the saddle.

#9 TELLER (D) (Stalker) Tries an all-weather track for the first time off a well-beaten third-place finish facing better at Prairie Meadows over one mile this month in his third outing. Son of Twirling Candy is a half-brother to one winner and trainer Tracy has won with 10% of runners this year. Gelding is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power and can be stalking the early pace with Felix riding.

#8 LAGRUE (U) (Speed) Was demoted to third after passing the post first after leading from the start in his latest over 5 furlongs at Fairmount this month and tries an all-weather track for the first time. Trainer Foxworth wins with 14% of his runners in maiden claiming events and son of Verrazano may be fastest early with Bailon in the irons.

#2 TALKTOEACHOTHER (U) (Presser) Was caught late after making a move to the lead over 6 ½ furlongs facing easier this month in his third start since being claimed by Blanca Candelas. Son of Bold Warrior has hit the board in four of his eight career outings and Candelas has won with 8% of runners at this meet. Bay can be in the early mix with Lopez up.

#3 COWBOYS FEATHER (D) (Closer) Comes off a non-threatening sixth-place finish in a maiden special weight event on grass over 5 furlongs this month in his fourth career start. Trainer Inman wins with 9% of his maiden claimers and son of Can the Man is a half-brother to one winner. Chestnut can be running late with Reyes remaining aboard.

#5 NUMERO PRIMO (U) (Stalker) Gets blinkers added off a fourth-place finish when making belated progress over 5 furlongs at Fairmount this month and will be on a synthetic surface for the first time. Son of Algorithms figures to be trying to close with Tavares riding.

#4 SINGER MCGEE (D) (Stalker) Stopped badly when unplaced at Turfway over one mile in his latest in early-January. Son of Warrior's Reward is a half-brother to three winners and trainer Martin wins with 10% that have not raced for 90+ days but gelding is likely best watched in his first outing after the long break.

#1 CAPTAIN CARNEGIE (E) (Presser) Showed early run before falling in his latest at Hawthorne in March. Gelding has some speed but is still a maiden after 23 outings and barn wins with just 4% of runners that have not raced for 90+ days.

Race 2

#1 SON OF GRACE (E) (Presser) Weakened some when fourth as the favorite over one mile at this level after vying for the early lead in his latest this month in his second start since being claimed by Larry Rivelli. Son of Temple City has hit the board in one of three starts and Rivelli wins with 34% of his runners that broke their maiden last time out and with 29% of his maiden claimers. Dark bay can be on or near the early lead with Baird retaining the mount.

#2 QUIET PRAYER (E) (Stalker) Narrowly missed when second over one mile at this level in his latest this month while hitting the board for the first time in four outings. Trainer Stidham wins with 18% of his runners on grass and with 26% in maiden claiming events. Son of Temple City is a half-brother to two winners and can be stalking the early pace with Carroll remaining aboard.

#3 BELLS OF JOY (U) (Closer) Was claimed by Mike Reavis when a non-threatening sixth over 5 furlongs on the Polytrack facing easier in his latest last month. Reavis wins with 29% of his runners first time off the claim and daughter of Bellamy Road is a half-sister to five winners. Filly facing males has hit the board in one of her four outings and can be a threat with Camacho riding.

#4 KIT KOWALESKI (E) (Closer) Finished well when third over one mile at this level in his latest earlier this month. Trainer Swearingen wins with 8% of his runners on turf and son of Kitten's Joy has hit the board in two of six starts on this course. Gelding can be running late with Bowen in the saddle.

#5 BEHAVIN MYSELF (D) (Presser) Weakened late when fourth after vying for the early lead facing better over one mile in his latest this month in his first start since being claimed by Patti Miller. Son of Malibu Moon has hit the board in one of six outings and Miller has won with 17% of her runners this meet. Gray can be forwardly placed early with Doyle in the irons.

#7 WEEKEND PASS (D) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced in a maiden special weight event at Fairmount over 6 furlongs in June in her second outing and tries turf for the first time. Filly may take to the surface being out of a mare by Dixieland Band and trainer Johns wins with 22% of his runners that have not raced for 90+ days.

#8 OFF TO THE BEACH (E) (Closer) Made belated progress when fifth at this level over one mile in his latest early this month. Gelding is still a maiden after 54 outings and barn wins with just 5% of runners in maiden special weight events.

#6 POINT OF DIRECTION (E) (Closer) Gets blinkers added for his first start for trainer Lenon off a never-threatening unplaced effort at this level over one mile at Louisiana Downs last month. Gelding has a good pedigree for turf but has been well-beaten in both outings and seems unlikely to find needed improvement to be a contender.

### Race 3

#1 RULER DAENERYS (E) (Presser) Weakened late when second after dueling for the lead from the start at this level and distance in her latest eight days ago. Trainer Sanchez has won with 18% of his runners this year and daughter of Road Ruler is a half-sister to one winner. Gray figures to be the one to catch breaking from the rail with Gallardo remaining aboard.

#2 COLOROFACLOUD (D) (Closer) Drops in class off a closing third-place finish over the track and distance in her latest this month. Daughter of Macho Uno has hit the board in five of her nine starts on

this oval and trainer Candelas wins with 16% of her runners dropping two classes. 4-year-old can be running late with Tavares retaining the mount.

#5 SHE'S SO CALI (D) (Closer) Gets class relief off a fading sixth-place finish over 5 furlongs on grass this month in her first start for trainer Cook. Daughter of California Chrome is a half-sister to three winners and Cook wins with 14% of his maiden claimers. Dark bay can be a factor from off the pace with Camacho again in the irons.

#7 FOX ABLE CHARLIE (D) (Presser) Faded to finish a well-beaten fifth after being involved early over the track and distance facing better this month. Trainer Inman wins with 9% of his maiden claimers and daughter of Liaison is a half-brother to one winner and can be in the early mix with Reyes riding.

#9 SENORITA AURORA (D) (Closer) Makes her first start on an all-weather track off a closing second-place finish at this distance in a maiden special weight event at Fairmount early this month. Daughter of Khozan is a half-sister to three winners and can be running late with Elizabeth Thurman in the irons.

#3 COUGAR (D) (Stalker) Comes off a fading sixth-place finish facing better over one mile on grass here eight days ago and tries the Polytrack for the first time. Gray has hit the board in five of her 15 career outings and trainer Perez wins with 11% of his maiden claimers. Daughter of The Factor can be near the front early with Santiago in the saddle.

#6 DARE TO HOPE (U) (Stalker) Faded to finish a well-beaten last of four over one mile at Fairmount facing easier in her latest in late-July. Daughter of Daredevil makes her third start for trainer Ali, who has won with 13% of his runners this year but filly has not hit the board in her 10 starts.

#8 CREAL ANGEL (U) (Closer) Gets blinkers added off a never-threatening unplaced effort at Fairmount facing easier late last month. Filly has hit the board in one of three career starts but needs to find some improvement to be a factor here.

#4 TIKA TOY (E) (Stalker) Gave way badly when unplaced at this level and distance in her latest eight days ago in her first start for trainer Perez and first on this Polytrack. Perez has won with 13% of his runners this year but filly has been well-beaten in all five of her outings.

#### Race 4

#12 JUNIOR BUG (E) (Stalker) Was claimed by Brittany Vanden Berg when closing some to finish second over 5 furlongs in his latest at this level one week ago in his second start after a near six month break. Son of Tapiture has a record of 8-1-2-2 on turf and Vanden Berg wins with 38% of her runners first time off the claim. Gelding can be near the front from the start with Emigh in the saddle.

#4 PRINCESS TINE (D) (Stalker) Weakened to finish second after making a bid for the lead from just off the pace facing better in her latest last month. Trainer Davis wins with 20% of his runners in claiming events and 3-year-old has hit the board in three of her seven starts on grass. Bay can be forwardly placed early with Doyle remaining aboard.

#3 SEMI CHARMED DAY (E) (Closer) Closed to finish second over the course and distance at this level in his latest last month and has hit the board in five of his seven starts on grass. Trainer Robertson wins with 24% of his claimers and with 13% of his runners on grass. Dark bay can be closing late with Roman retaining the mount.

#7 TOM'S LAST GENERAL (D) (Closer) Drops in class off a second-place finish from just off the pace over 6 furlongs on the main track earlier this month. Dark bay has a record of 14-1-3-3 on grass and can be running from off the pace into contention with Tavares in the saddle.

#9 SYMBOLIST (U) (Presser) Was involved from the start when second at this distance on the main track in his latest early this month. Son of Daaher failed to hit the board in two previous starts on grass but trainer Manley wins with 13% of his runners on turf and bay can be in the early mix with Baird riding.

#5 HALF COCKED (D) (Closer) Was caught late after leading from the start when third over 1 1/16 miles facing better in his latest two weeks ago in his first start after a short break. Trainer Puhich wins with 12% of his runners second off a layoff and gray has won one of 10 career starts. Son of Raison d'Etat can be in the early mix with Bowen aboard.

#2 DRAW THE LINE (E) (Closer) Made some progress when fourth over the course and distance last month in his first start since being claimed by Antonio Meraz and third outing after a short break. Meraz wins with 31% of his runners second off the claim and gelding can be running late but has not hit the board in six starts on turf.

#1 DOM CAETANO (U) (Closer) Closed some when fourth over the course and distance in his latest this month in his second start for trainer Matthews. Gelding has won one of three starts on this turf and Matthews wins with 16% of his claimers. Bay can be closing late with Hernandez in the irons.

#6 POWERFUL MAN (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced after pressing the early pace over 6 furlongs on the main track six days ago in his second start since being claimed by Fernando Bahena. 3-year-old failed to hit the board in one previous start on grass but Bahena has won with 19% of his runners at this meet and colt can be near the front early.

#10 LITTLE TOOT (U) (Presser) Was involved from the start when breaking his maiden on the main track in his latest this month. Trainer Granitz wins with 14% of his runners that broke their maiden last time out and son of Mineshaft can be a pace factor with apprentice Lopez up.

#8 CACHACO (E) (Stalker) Comes off a well-beaten fifth-place finish over 5 furlongs one week ago. Trainer Hernandez wins with 12% of his claimers but gelding failed to hit the board in two previous starts on grass.

#11 LOCASH (U) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace when breaking her maiden over the course and distance last month in her first start for trainer Slager. Gray showed improvement in her latest outing but still needs more to be a factor here.

#13 OXBOW'S RUBY (E) (Closer) Was not a threat when unplaced over the course and distance at this level in her latest early this month. Dark bay seems unlikely to be a factor if drawing in off the AE list.

#### Race 5

#4 SIMPLE LOGIC (E) (Stalker) Comes off a second-place finish in an even effort over 5 ½ furlongs early this month. Trainer Rainwater wins with 29% of runners in allowance events and son of Maclean's Music has a record of 4-1-1-1 on this main track. 3-year-old can be in good position from the start with Bowen in the saddle.

#2 GIROLAMO'GLORY (U) (Closer) Was prominent from the start when a close second at this distance at Fairmount three weeks ago. Son of Girolamo has won five of 23 career starts and trainer Plasters has won with 18% of her runners at this meet. 5-year-old is ranked first on BRIS Prime Power but failed to hit the board in two previous starts on this oval.

#9 BEEALEA (E) (Closer) Finished fifth in an even effort over 5 ½ furlongs at this level in his latest early this month. Chestnut has won one of his three starts on this oval and trainer Boyce has won with 33% of her runners this meet. Son of Lea can be closing late for a chance at a share with Roman retaining the mount.

#8 GIVIN UP NONE (U) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace when defeating easier over 5 furlongs on grass here six days ago. Trainer Hughes failed to win with his last 43 runners in allowance events but gray has a record of 8-1-2-2 on this Polytrack and can be a factor with Tavares riding.

#7 Z U SOON (E) (Stalker) Comes off a fourth-place finish in an even effort over 5 ½ furlongs at this level last month. Son of Congrats has a record of 14-2-1-3 on this oval and trainer Young wins with 12% of his runners in allowance events. 6-year-old can be running late with Emigh remaining aboard.

#5 FLASHY RICHIE (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced over 5 ½ furlongs in his latest earlier this month. Trainer Rodriguez wins with 18% of his runners in allowance events and gelding has won one of his four starts on this track. Son of Flashback can be closing late with Felix again in the saddle.

#6 MON AMI FUZZLE (U) (Stalker) Made some belated progress while a well-beaten fourth at this distance at Fairmount last month in his first start after a short break. Trainer Bahena wins with 18% of his runners second off a layoff but dark bay showed little in one previous start on this oval.

#1 BABA'S BOY (U) (Presser) Weakened when third at this distance at Fairmount in his latest last month and tries an all-weather surface for the first time. Gelding can be a brief pace factor with apprentice Lopez up.

#3 DEMAND RANSOM (U) (Closer) Was not a threat when unplaced over 5 furlongs on grass facing easier last six days ago. Barn failed to win with last 43 runners in allowance events and son of Munnings has not won in a long time.

#### Race 6

#10 PRINCESS STELLA (D) (Presser) Makes her first start for trainer Rivelli off a weakening fourth-place finish after leading early over one mile earlier this month. Rivelli win with 29% of his runner first time for his barn and has won with 36% of his starters at this meet. Daughter of Competitive Edge has won one of her five starts on grass and can be in the early mix with Baird retaining the mount.

#3 BASEBALL POLITICS (E) (Presser) Comes off a fading fifth-place finish after leading early when claimed by Chris Davis in his latest over one mile on the main track last month. Davis wins with 27% of his runners first time off the claim and son of Midnight Lute finished fourth in one previous start on grass. Dark bay can be near the front early under Doyle, who has won with 15% of her rides for the barn in the past two months.

#9 MEDAL OF FACT (D) (Presser) Weakened late after dueling for the early lead over the course and distance facing better in his latest last month. Son of The Factor has hit the board in two of his four

starts on this turf and trainer Cook wins with 12% of his runners in sprint races. Gelding can be in the early mix with Roman in the irons.

#5 RULE FOLLOWER (E) (Speed) Was claimed by Steve Fridley when giving way badly after vying for the early lead in his latest over one mile on the Polytrack at this level last month in his second start of the year. Fridley has won with 7% of his runners this year and son of Algorithms may be the one to catch with Emigh riding.

#4 LONESOME DREAM (E) (Stalker) Tries grass for the first time off a second-place finish when making some progress at Fairmount in his latest last month. Dark bay does not have a great pedigree for the surface but trainer Higgins won with one of his two runners at this meet and gelding can be near the front early with Santiago aboard.

#2 MAXIMILIANO (D) (Presser) Gave way to finish unplaced over 5 ½ furlongs at Prairie Meadows in his latest last month in his first start for trainer Tracy and first outing since April. Tracy wins with 13% of his runners second off a layoff and son of Quality Road may show more here with Lopez up.

#8 NAVY PIER (U) (Stalker) Was involved from the start when breaking his maiden over the course and distance in his latest last month. Trainer Winebaugh wins with 15% of her claimers and son of Summer Front can be forwardly placed early under Carroll, who has won with two of his last four rides for the barn.

#6 MAC PANDOWDY (U) (Stalker) Tries grass for the first time off a fading fifth-place finish over 6 furlongs at Fairmount last month. Gelding has won one of his four career starts but needs improvement to be a factor here.

#7 ON THE MUSCLE (U) (Closer) Faded to finish unplaced facing easier over 1 1/16 miles in his latest two weeks ago in his first start since being claimed by Earl Hughes. Son of More Than Ready has won just one of his 17 career starts and is unlikely to be a threat.

#1 COCO BRAVADO (E) (Closer) Comes off a weakening fourth-place finish over 6 furlongs on the Polytrack at this level early this month. Barn wins with just 4% of runners in claiming events and dark bay has won just one of his 19 career outings.

#### Race 7

#1 TEMPER TANTRUM (E) (Stalker) Rallied from just off the pace when winning his latest over the course and distance last month. Chestnut has a record of 4-3-1-0 on this turf and trainer Rivelli wins with 33% of his runners that won last time out and has won with 36% of his starters at this meet. Son of Flashback has won his last three outings and can be in good position from the start with Emigh remaining aboard.

#2 W W CRAZY (D) (Stalker) Makes his turf debut off a closing fourth-place finish in the St Louis Derby at Fairmount over 1 1/16 miles last month in his first start after a short break. Son of Jess's Dream is a half-brother to one winner on grass and trainer Becker has won with 35% of his runners this year. Gelding can be a factor from off the pace under Santiago, who has won with 53% of his rides for the barn in the past 60 days.

#3 EYE OF THE CAT (D) (Closer) Faded to finish unplaced in the Virginia Derby (G3) in his latest at Colonial Downs over 9 furlongs last month. Son of Run Away and Hide has hit the board in both of two

starts on this turf and trainer Catalano wins with 19% of his runners on grass. 3-year-old can be running from off the pace with Camacho in the irons.

#10 EPIMYTHIUM (U) (Stalker) Made progress when second at this distance at Kentucky Downs in a starter allowance event earlier this month. Gray has a record of 3-1-1-1 on turf and trainer Meah has won with six of her 15 runners at this meet. Son of Muskatier can be stalking the early pace with Achard riding.

#7 KOBLA MAS (E) (Closer) Closed belatedly when fifth over one mile and 70 yards in his latest at Delaware in early-June. Trainer Stidham wins with 19% of his runners that have not raced for 90+ days and with 18% of his starters on turf. Son of More Than Ready can be closing late with Bowen up.

#12 SMOKEY HARBOR (E) (Closer) Comes off a fourth-place finish in an even effort over the course and distance early this month. Dark bay has won two of six starts on grass and trainer Faucheux wins with 22% of his runners in allowance events and with 19% of his starters on grass. Dark bay can be running from off the pace with Felix in the saddle.

#11 CLEMSON TIGER (E) (Speed) Gave way badly after leading early over 1 1/16 miles in the Polytrack in his latest last month. Chestnut won one of his two previous starts on grass and trainer Reavis wins with 19% of his runners on turf. Son of Noble Mission may be sent early with Baird riding.

#4 NIP N TUCK (E) (Presser) Comes off a third-place finish after leading early over the course and distance at this level this month in his second start since being claimed by Mike Reavis. Son of Stay Thirsty has hit the board in all three starts on grass and Reavis wins with 17% of his runners in allowance events. Colt can be near the front from the start with Lopez in the irons.

#5 CLARESTOWN (E) (Closer) Weakened some when fifth after chasing the early pace over the course and distance in his latest this month. Trainer Block wins with 15% of his allowance runners and son of Speightstown has a record of 7-1-0-2 on turf. Chestnut can be trying to close with Tavares in the saddle.

#8 TEXAS GANO (U) (Closer) Rallied from off the pace when defeating easier over 7 furlongs at Mountaineer in his latest last month. Dark bay has won two of his seven career starts on grass and trainer West has won with 14% of his runners this year. Colt should find a solid pace to close into with Doyle riding.

#9 AGENT PETER GRAVES (E) (Presser) Comes off a weakening fifth-place finish at this distance at Ellis last month in his first start for trainer Morey and first outing after a short break. Morey wins with 16% of his runner on grass and son of Noble Mission has won one of his two starts on turf. Chestnut can be a pace factor with Carroll aboard.

#6 TWO COOKIE RULE (U) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced over 1 1/16 miles facing easier in his latest here last month. Trainer Poulos wins with 12% of her runners on grass and gelding has won one of his four starts on turf but needs improvement to be a contender.

#### Race 8

#6 DASTARDLY DEEDS (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced facing open company on turf over one mile in his latest eight days ago in his third outing. Son of Warrior's Reward hit the board in one previous

start on this Polytrack and trainer Block wins with 13% of his runners in maiden special weight events. 4-year-old can be stalking the early pace with Roman in the irons.

#2 CLASSOFSIXTYSEVEN (E) (Stalker) Closed from off the pace when second over 5 furlongs on grass in his latest last month in his second start of the year. Dark bay hit the board in his one previous start on this main track and trainer Young wins with 20% of his runners third time off a layoff. Gelding can be running from just off the pace with Lopez retaining the mount.

#4 LOOK AWAY (E) (Stalker) Weakened some when third over 6 furlongs in his latest early last month. Trainer Jones looks for first winner of the meet but son of Tizway is a half-brother to three winners and can be a contender for a share with apprentice Lopez riding.

#7 MOMMAS BOY OTIS (E) (Presser) Gets blinkers added off a weakening fifth-place finish after vying for the early lead over 5 furlongs on grass here last month. Trainer DeLong has won with just one of his 28 runners at this meet but son of Firing Line has hit the board in two of five starts on this oval and can be on or near the early lead with Bowen remaining aboard.

#9 DEORA STORE (U) (Stalker) Tries an all-weather track for the first time and has not raced since weakening to finish third over 6 furlongs at Hawthorne in December. Dark bay has hit the board in two of his four starts and trainer Kirby wins with 11% of his runners that have not raced for 90+ days. Son of Indy Snow can be forwardly placed early with Emigh in the saddle.

#1 THE LAST FACT (E) (Stalker) Faded to finish unplaced after chasing the early pace over 5 furlongs on grass last month in his second outing. Son of El Medwar is a half-brother to four winners and may show some speed from the rail with Sanchez up.

#8 DASH TO THE CASH (E) (Closer) Was not a factor when unplaced over 5 furlongs on grass in his debut last month. Trainer Lindsay looks for first winner of the year and gray needs to find improvement to be a factor.

#3 GOOD YEGG (U) (Stalker) Comes off a fading unplaced effort over one mile on grass facing easier this month. Gelding has hit the board in one of four starts on this Polytrack but needs some improvement on recent outings to be a contender.

#5 KING'S STORY (E) (Presser) Gave way badly when unplaced over 6 furlongs in his latest early last month. Trainer Haran has won with just 4% of his runners at this meet and gelding is a maiden after 13 tries but can be a brief pace factor.

Race 4

#12 JUNIOR BUG (E) (Stalker) Was claimed by Brittany Vanden Berg when closing some to finish second over 5 furlongs in his latest at this level one week ago in his second start after a near six month break. Son of Tapiture has a record of 8-1-2-2 on turf and Vanden Berg wins with 38% of her runners first time off the claim. Gelding can be near the front from the start with Emigh in the saddle.

#### Race 6

#10 PRINCESS STELLA (D) (Presser) Makes her first start for trainer Rivelli off a weakening fourth-place finish after leading early over one mile earlier this month. Rivelli win with 29% of his runner first time for his barn and has won with 36% of his starters at this meet. Daughter of Competitive Edge has won one of her five starts on grass and can be in the early mix with Baird retaining the mount.
